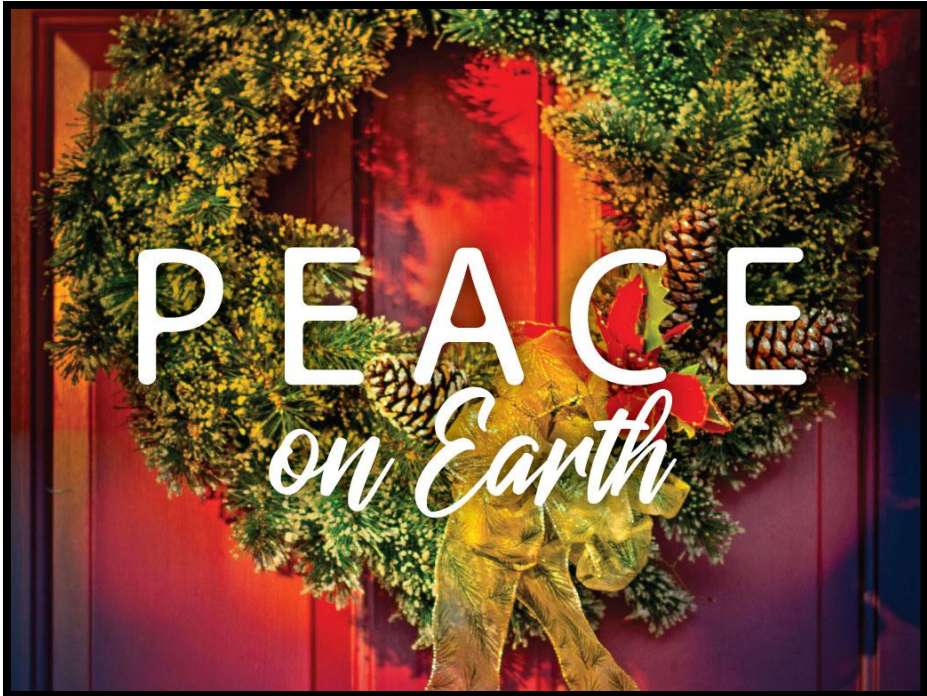

Mission

In response to God's Word, we embrace and nurture vulnerable children and families by providing homes, healing and hope.

Prayer Focus

For the month of December, we participate in White Christmas for Embrace Alabama Kids. Besides monetary donations, this mission is always in need of our prayers. So what can we specifically pray for?

1. Pray that everything possible can be done to keep biological families together, but when this isn't possible, pray that there are enough foster families that are willing to open their homes to these children to provide a safe and loving environment.
2. Pray that any child in this program that requires any therapeutic special need (such as medical complications, social maladjustment, emotional/behavioral issues) will receive the proper therapy.
3. Pray that siblings are able to stay together.
4. Pray that the processes in place to provide support and intervention are successful so that children can stay with their own families or transitioning to return to their families can occur.
5. Pray for DHR to help Embrace Alabama Kids to develop a family-specific intervention plan to aid each child.
6. Specific Residential Homes need our prayers.
 - **Babies First** – Teen mothers that have experienced neglect or abuse are provided stability that leads to growth in emotional, spiritual, and social intelligence.
 - **The Settlement** – A home for teen boys to develop trust and love, and they are provided support to achieve their high school diploma and/or a training program for a career.
 - **Transitional/Independent Living** – Helps to provide an apartment for a youth leaving foster care that is not ready to completely flourish on their own. This aids with developing independent living skills without carrying the full weight of independence.
7. Pray to see if God is calling you to be a part of this mission as a foster parent.
