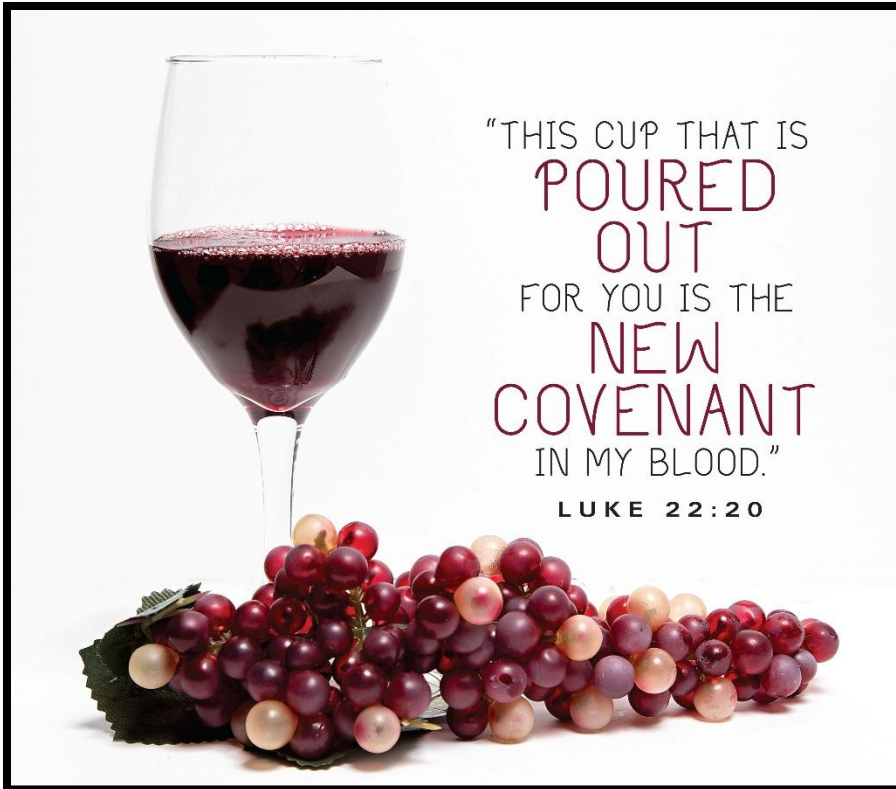

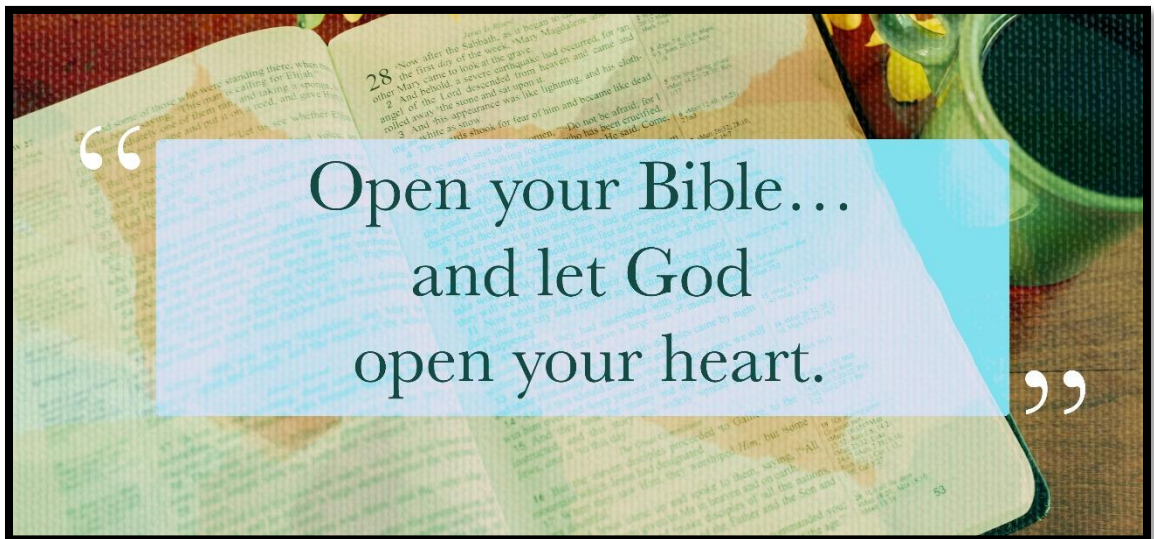

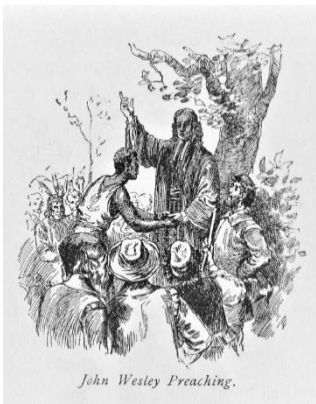

Wesley's Covenant Prayer

Modern Version



Last Sunday, Bishop Carolyn Moore shared with us John Wesley's "Prayer Covenant," which he introduced in 1775. Typically prayed at the beginning of each new year, the prayer became an important art of the Methodist and Wesleyan tradition renewing a covenant to pray. It emphasizes self-examination, reflection, and commitment to God. It encourages believers to live out their faith in community and service to others. It is presented here in more contemporary language.

"I am no longer my own, but yours.

Put me to what you will; place me with whom you will.

Put me to doing; put me to suffering.

Let me be put to work for you or set aside for you, praised for you or criticized for you.

Let me be full; let me be empty.

Let me have all things; let me have nothing.

I freely and fully surrender all things to your glory and service.

And now, O wonderful and holy God, Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer, you are mine, and I am yours.

So be it. And the covenant which I have made on earth, let it also be made in heaven. Amen."

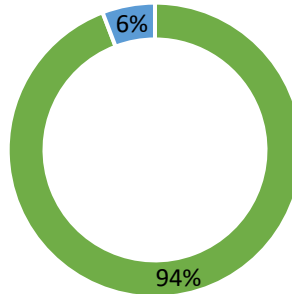
