Today as we partake of Communion we reflect upon the meaning of the New Covenant. No longer do we have to conform in outward appearance to the stated requirements of the Law of Moses with unregenerated hearts, but now through the inward transforming of the Holy Spirit, we are enabled to walk in a manner pleasing to the Lord – Holiness. As a “means of grace,” John Wesley viewed

Communion as a visible expression of Jesus's presence through which we express our faith in his forgiving and sanctifying power. Therefore, Wesley encourages believers to receive Communion as often as possible as a spiritually enriching opportunity. We at Wesley Chapel observe Communion on the first Sunday of each month, Christmas Eve, and Resurrection Sunday.

Following is Wesley's prayer he prayed as a renewal of the believer's commitment to the New Covenant. It is presented here, and I invite you to pray with the congregation as we renew our commitment to the New Covenant. If you are not a believer, you are invited to first seek God's forgiveness and partake with us as an expression of saving faith and spiritual awakening.

"I am no longer my own, but yours.

Put me to what you will; place me with whom you will.

Put me to doing; put me to suffering.

*Let me be put to work for you or set aside for you, praised for you or
criticized for you.*

Let me be full; let me be empty.

Let me have all things; let me have nothing.

I freely and fully surrender all things to your glory and service.

*And now, O wonderful and holy God, Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer,
you are mine, and I am yours.*

*So be it. And the covenant which I have made on earth, let it also be
made in heaven. Amen."*

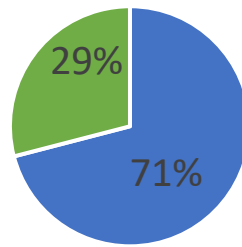
