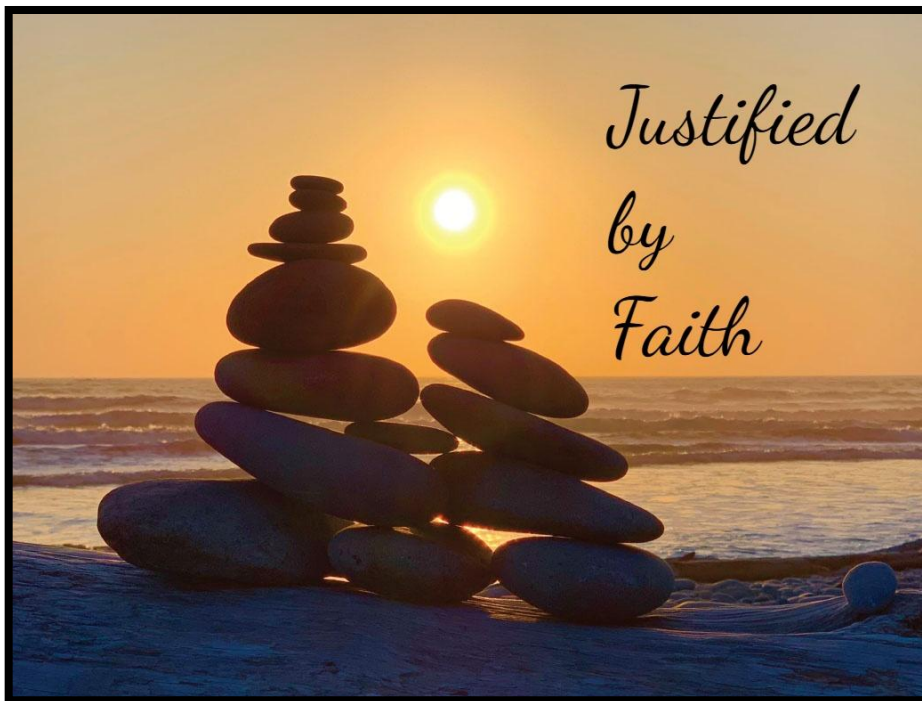

Pray for Foster Children and Parents

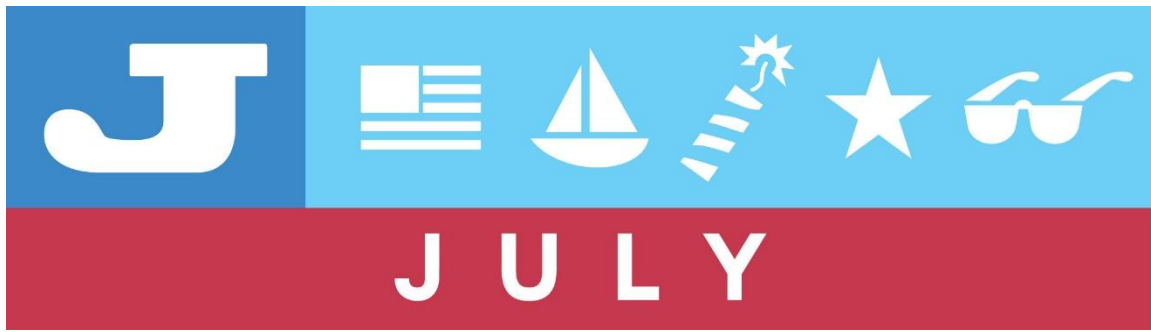
Did you know that the state of Alabama has around 6,000 children in need of foster care? Some of the children need care for a few days, others need care until they can be reunited with their biological families. Adoption plans are established for the rest. The average foster child needs care for 618 days.

The children in foster care come from many social, economic, and ethnic groups. Some of these children are coming from places or experiences that have placed them at risk. These risks are things such as neglect, physical abuse or sexual abuse. Teens in foster care usually have varying degrees of mental, physical or emotional problems. The children that have siblings in foster care are kept together if possible as well.

Wesley Chapel supports DHR in Talladega County with school supplies for the beginning of the school year, and at Christmas, we have an angel tree in place that provides foster children with Christmas gifts. In December, we also participate in White Christmas. This is a program with Embrace Alabama Kids, and this fundraiser supports foster children throughout our state.

We all know that the children need our prayers to make sure that their needs are met in a safe, loving, caring and committed family whether it is a temporary or permanent situation. Be in prayer for the existing foster homes, and the agencies that provide help to organize, administrate and place children in these homes. These agencies collect financial help for the children and the foster families as well.

Talladega County has 39 foster homes, but they are in need of more families. Pray that there are enough foster families available for the children in our county. Pray for guidance to see if you may be the one being called to be a foster parent.
