Key Teaching Points

Questions

We looked at the relationship between Peter and Jesus a lot in this message. Is there a certain story from Peter's life that really stands out to you? Which one, and why? Does that story line up with any of the teaching points above?

What is one of the biggest barriers to investing your TIME in someone else right now?

In the message, Tim said that investing in others can pay off in ways we may not see in this life. Does that encourage or discourage you to know?

Tim also said that investing in others may make a greater difference in our own hearts and lives than it does in those we invest in. Have you ever known that to be true? In other words, have you ever been blessed or felt like you grew in your faith through serving or investing in someone else? When/how?

At the end of the message, Tim challenged us to "say their name," that is to speak out loud the name of the person God is laying on our hearts to invest in. What is the name of the person you feel led to invest your life in moving forward?

If you could have friends praying for you about just one thing for you this week, what would it be?
