ECCLESIASTES 4:12 NLT

A person standing alone can be attacked and defeated, but two can stand back-to-back and conquer. Three are even better, for a triple-braided cord is not easily broken.

ILLUS

Back in the 1600's William Lantan was the captain of a ship headed for Barbados.

A thousand miles off the coast his vessel sprang a leak, and he had the crew take refuge in their longboat.

They had a plentiful supply of bread, but little water. After 18 days of drifting they were down to a tablespoon per man a day. They knew their days were numbered.

Meanwhile, another ship captain by the name of Samuel Scarlet was having his problems.

They were almost out of food, but had plenty of water. They spotted the longboat and rescued them

Each party discovered the other had what they lacked. One had bread for all, and the other had water for all. Both crews would have perished without the other, but together they supplied each other's need for survival.
