- Favoring the compliant child
- Comparing them with other children
- Over protection Under protection
- Parental apathy and neglect
- Over correction,
- Forgetting they are just kids
- Withholding discipline.... doesn't work, or to traumatic of an experience
- Setting our expectations to high or low... school, sports...
- Patterns of marital disharmony
- Constant criticism of the bad, no acknowledgment of the good
- Hypocrisy, double standards,
- Modeling anger
- Not owning sins
- Too many rules, or no rules, rules without relationship

4. Ways parents provoke/encourage children

- 1. When we discipline them with the rod P or E
- 2. When we shelter them from the world P or E
- 3. When we make them our "buddy" P or E
- 4. When we allow them to view us as ultimate authority P or E
- 5. When we withhold the rod P or E
- 6. When we confront their sinful behavior P or E
- 7. When we lecture them P or E
- 8. When we treat them like children P or E
- 9. When we make excuses for them P or E
- 10. When we yell at them P or E
