Hermeneutics: How do we read the Bible?

- Say? – Original author to original audience
- Mean? – Timeless truths about God and humanity
- Apply? – How does this truth impact our life

Orthodoxy: What are our beliefs?

1. God – Nature and reality of God
2. Man – Position of humanity before God
3. Jesus' life – Two natures, perfectly righteous
4. Jesus' death – Real, Volitional & Vicarious
5. Jesus' resurrection – Real, Physical, First fruits
6. Salvation by grace through faith (alone)

Orthopraxy: What are our practices?

1. God
 - a. Bible reading – Listening
 - b. Prayer – Speaking
2. Church
 - a. Corporate – Sit under Bible teaching, Praise, Fellowship
 - b. Small Group/Class room – Able to process your faith
 - c. Accountability – Able to process your life, war on sin, set spiritual goals
3. World

 - b. On mission
