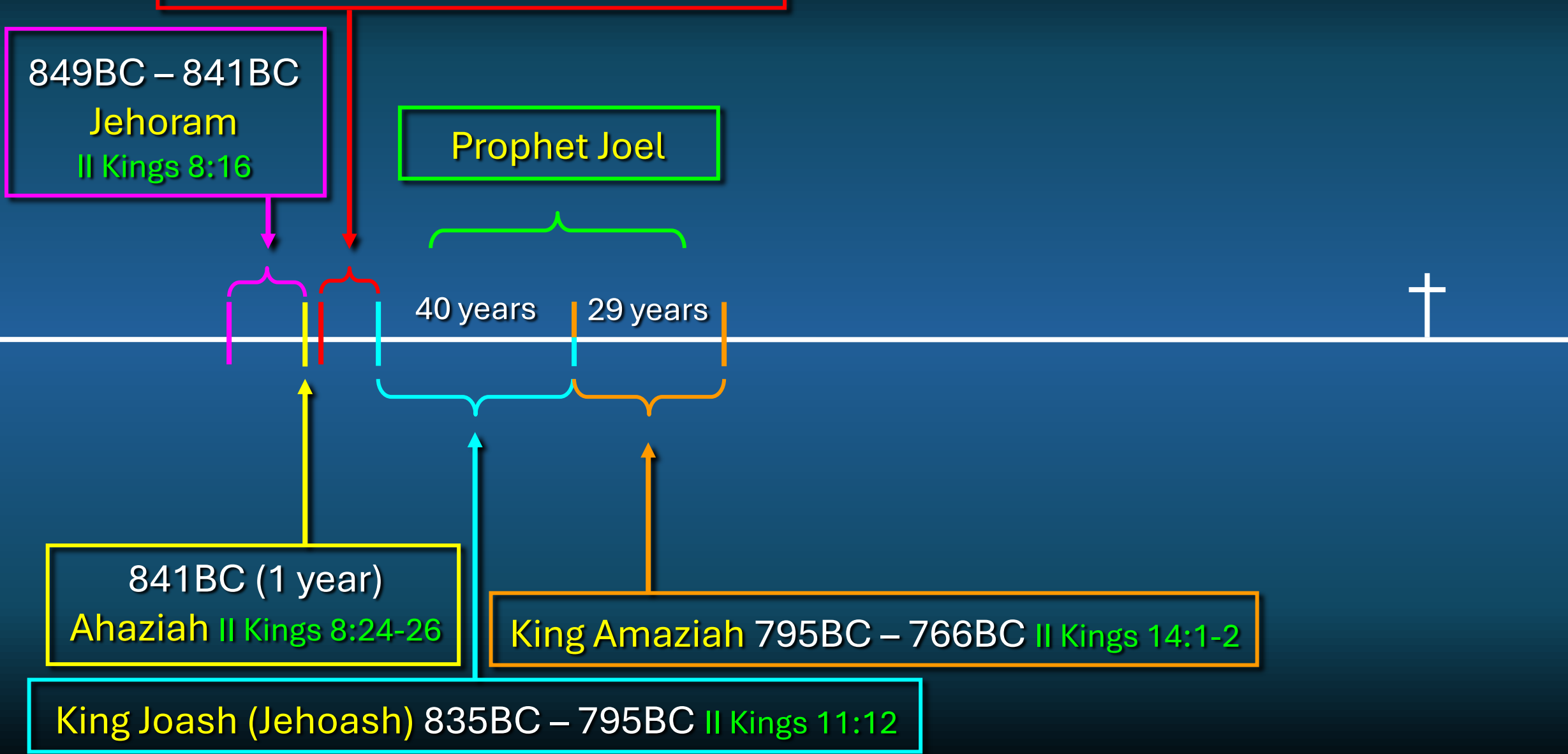
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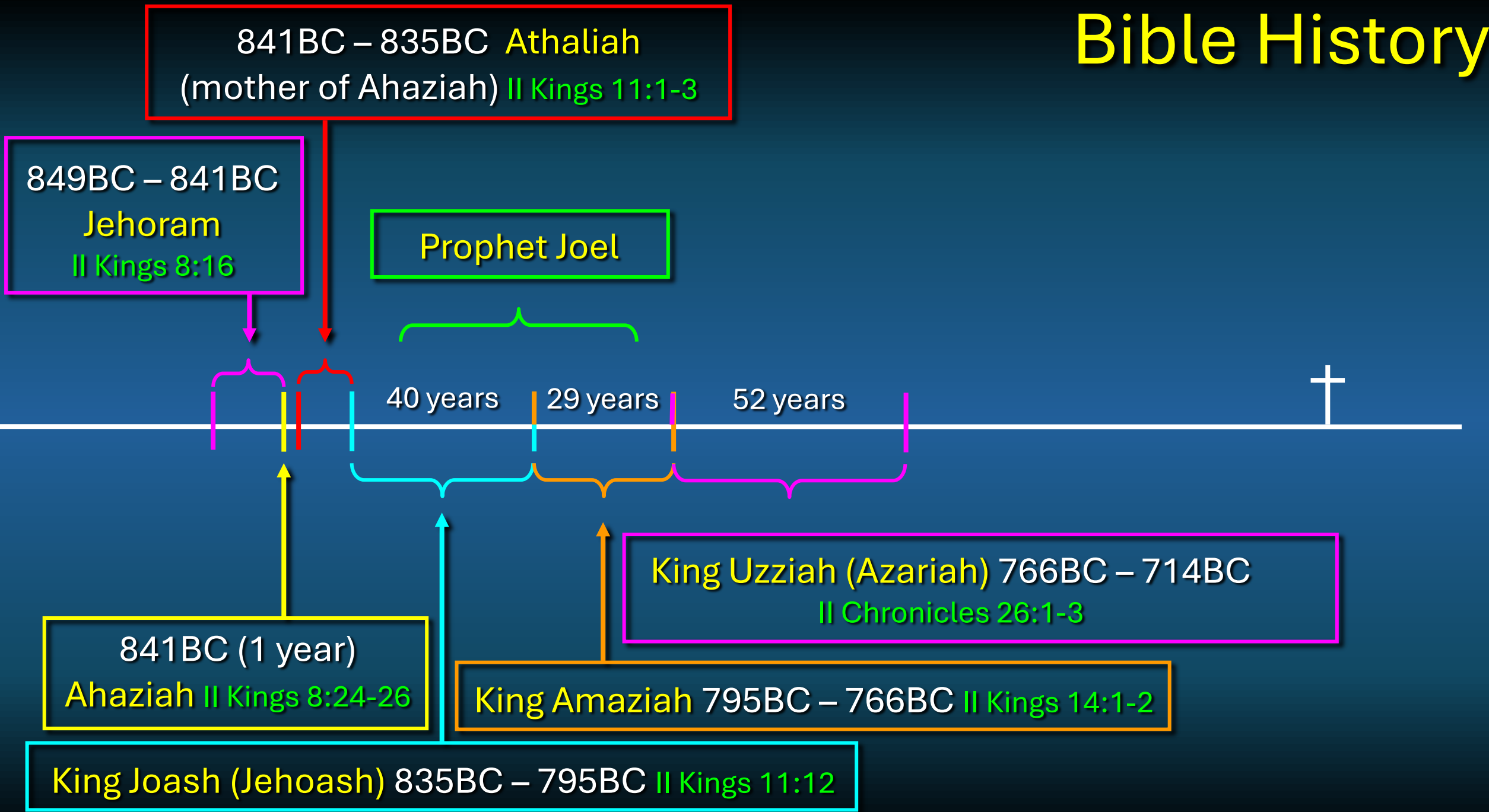
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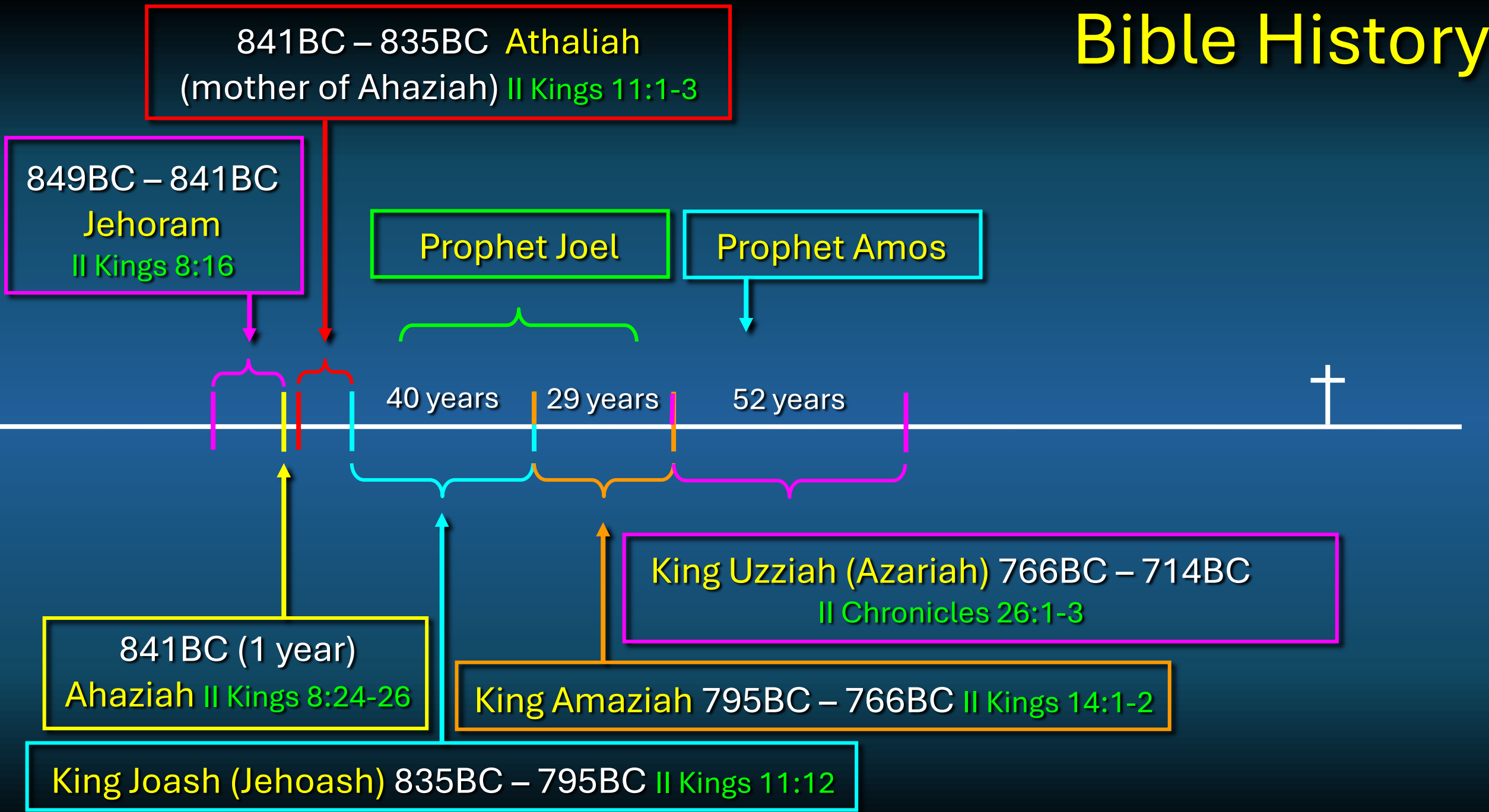

- Eat their body weight in vegetation each day

- Eat their body weight in vegetation each day
- Can grow up to 10" in length



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Locust

- Eat their body weight in vegetation each day
- Can grow up to 10" in length
- Swarm – causes aggression, changes color, physiology, metabolism and behavior
- Swarms consist of massive numbers of locust
- **Reproduction rates are unimaginable**



Locust

Gazam (גָּזָם [H1501]) gnawing locust (palmerworm)

- Emerges from the egg (in spring); has no wings

Arbe (אַרְבֶּה [H696]) swarming locust

- Most common winged locust

Chasil (חָסִיל [H2625]) licking locust (caterpillar)

Yeleq (יֵלֵק [H3218]) Consuming locust (cankerworm)

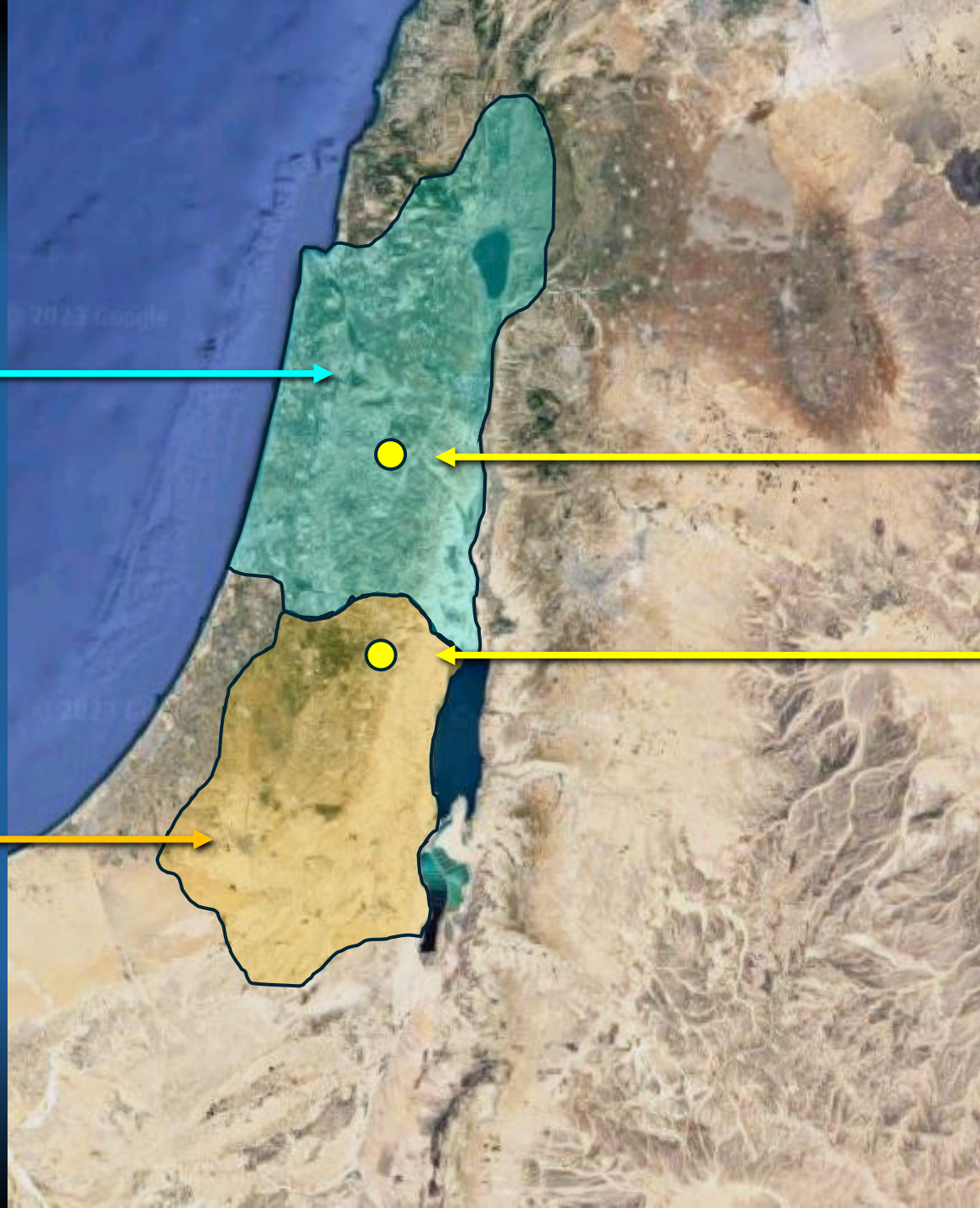
