- Reproduction rates are unimaginable



- Gazam ([H1501]) gnawing locust (palmerworm)
- Emerges from the egg (in spring); has no wings
- Arbe (אָרֶבֶּה [H696]) swarming locust
- Most common winged locust
- Chasil (סְילן [H2625]) licking locust (caterpillar)
- Yeleq (יֻלֶּקְ [H3218]) Consuming locust (cankerworm)


