Planes Patrolling Meat Strike Area

Minnesota Troops Mobilized to Prevent Recurrence of Violence

SOUTH ST. PAUL, Minn., May 14 (UP)—National Guard combat planes patrolled packing house areas tonight while ground troops mobilized to prevent a recurrence of strike violence climaxed when 200 men smashed into one meat plant armed with knives and clubs.

Gov. Luther Youngdahl ordered the Guard mobilized after three days of mounting tension in the bitter strike of CIO United Packinghouse Workers. Union lines thinned out under new union orders to picket peacefully while troops assembled at armories to be outfitted.

The invasion of the Cudahy plant at Newport occurred early today when the guard of about 200, armed with clubs, knives and hammers, smashed the lock on the plant gate and surged inside.

The abducted workers, some of them badly beaten, were carried by autos to county roads.

Police Cars Rushed to Kansas City Plant

KANSAS CITY, Kan., May 14 (AP)—All police cars in service were dispatched to the Armour & Co. plant tonight following a report of trouble involving strikers there, but Police Lt. Lester Riley said everything was under control when the police arrived. Bricks were thrown at a motorcar driven by a postal messenger seeking to deliver a special delivery letter at the plant, police said. "A large crowd" of strikers was reported near the plant.

WASHINGTON, May 14 (AP)—Sen. Vandenberg (R) Mich., was guarded by Capitol police late yesterday and this morning after his office received an anonymous telephone call that "he'd better circle round."

Arthur Vandenberg Jr. said his father, frequently mentioned as a Presidential possibility, "is not the least bit alarmed."

He said the Capitol police insisted on giving the Senator a guard until noon today.

Phone Call to Office
This is the story related by young Vandenberg:

About noon yesterday, a stenographer in Vandenberg's office answered the telephone and a voice said:

"This is the guard. Tell Arthur he'd better circle around. He'll know what I mean."

Young Vandenberg called the guard to see what the call meant—but the guard denied making the call.

"At that point," said Vandenberg Jr., "the guard became alarmed."

"They insisted father have a guard during the rest of the day. The guard stayed on duty until noon today."

He said, "We don't consider there is any cause for alarm."

Hawaii Alert After Quake in Aleutians

Fear of Tidal Wave Sends Islanders Hurrying to Hills

SEATTLE, May 14 (AP)—Tidal wave alerts sent shoreline residents in Hawaii streaming into the hills and caused precautions to be taken in the Aleutians following an earthquake west of Dutch Harbor in the Aleutians.

However, as hours passed without a sign of the waves, authorities expressed belief that the danger was over.

The only report of the quake being felt on the water came from the motor vessel Square Knot 100 miles or less northwest of Unimak Island. It reported "a severe earthquake with a violent bouncing motion experienced on a smooth sea."

Stations Alert
On the basis of the report the Ketchikan Coast Guard Base alerted all Coast Guard stations in the Aleutians against possible tidal waves.

The same report, relayed to Hilo in Hawaii, which lost 175 persons in a tidal wave in 1946, caused a rush to higher ground. Swimmers were warned away from beaches and the military services were alerted. The alert later was canceled.

Equipment Moved
In the Aleutians, also, equipment at Coast Guard stations was moved to higher ground and all personnel alerted. However, several hours after the original quake, messages from such points as Ft. Glenn, Nikolsky, Cape Sarachef and Scotch Cap reported no sign of tidal waves.

It was at Scotch Cap off Unimak Island that 10 Coast Guardsmen were lost in the tidal waves which also hit Hawaii. The waves destroyed the Scotch Cap lighthouse installation.

Attack Comes After British End Mandate

Casualties Reported in All-Jewish City; Planes Unidentified

TEL AVIV, Israel, May 15 (Saturday) (AP)—Air raiders bombed this all-Jewish city at dawn today only a few hours after the new Jewish state of Israel had been proclaimed.

First reports said casualties were one dead and six injured. Tel Aviv Airport workers said Jewish fighters drove off the attacking planes, which they said appeared to be fighter-bomber types.

Six bombs fell at the edge of the airport, near the power and light station. Casualties were suffered when one bomb smashed a building. Tel Aviv was under complete blackout all night.

The attacking planes were not identified as to nationality. Britain surrendered her 25-year-old mandate over Palestine at midnight and one minute later Israel officially came into existence.

Threat of Invasion

The newly born Jewish state faced an immediate threat of blood as Arab nations of the Middle East, awaiting the end of the mandate to launch their regular armies on an invasion of the Holy Land, poised troops on its frontiers and sent probing forces across the border.

White House Promises More Action in Effort to End Palestine Strife

WASHINGTON, May 14 (UP)—President Truman, who had abandoned the U.S. partition plan for Palestine, tonight dramatically announced U.S. recognition of the Jewish state of Israel 20 minutes after it came into existence.

At the same time, the President's spokesman, White House Secretary Charles G. Ross, announced the determination of this country to continue its efforts to obtain a truce in Palestine between the Arabs and Jews and to appeal to the new Jewish state to support United States efforts to stop the fighting.

Mr. Truman's brief statement announcing recognition of Israel said:

"This government has been informed that a Jewish state has been proclaimed in Palestine, and recognition has been requested by the provisional government thereof.

"The United States recognizes the provisional government as the de facto authority of the new state of Israel."

U.N. Delegates Amazed

Mr. Truman's decision had been kept a top secret of the highest level for two days. Even many officials of the State Department were surprised by the announcement.

News of the recognition amazed United Nations delegates in New York. No delegation was more surprised than that of the United States.
