Bad portion of Sheol.  
The abode of the unsaved dead  
people prior to the Great White  
Throne judgement (Rev 20:11-15)  
It is a prison (1 Peter 3:19).  
It has gates, bars and locks  
(Matthew 16;18 & Revelation 1:18)

## The Bottomless Pit (Abousso)

Luke 8:31, Revelation 9, 11:7, 17:8, 20:1-3  
Angel of the BP: Apollyon (Revelation 9:11)  
Satan bound for 1,000 years (Revelation 20)  
Demon Locust emerge from the BP (Revelation 9)

## Tartarus (II Peter 2:4)

Deepest abyss of Hell. Everlasting Chains under darkness.  
Fallen angels that left their first estate are currently there (Jude 1:6).

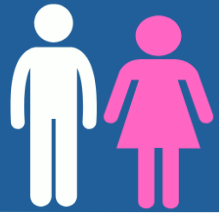
