Pollutions of Idols

Do Not: Make them (Exodus 20:4)

Bow down to them or serve them (Exodus 20:5)

Own them, set them up in your land (Leviticus 26:1)

Set them up in your home (Deut. 7:25-26)

Do: Burn them, hate them (Deut. 7:25-26)

All Idols: Have demons (Deut. 32:16-17, II Chronicles 11:13-16, I

Corinthians 10:19-21) are cursed (Deut. 7:25-26)

Little children, keep
yourselves from
idols. Amen.

Forbidden: Adultery (Exodus 20:14), Lust (Matthew 5:27-28)

Fornication (I Corinthians 6:18-7:9),

Homosexuality (Leviticus 18:22, Romans 1:26-27, I Corinthians 6:9-10)

Incest (Leviticus 18:6-18) Prostitution (Leviticus 19:29, Matthew 5:28)

Bestiality (Leviticus 18:23) Necrophilia (Numbers 19:11-16)

Gentiles Abstain From

Blood

Do Not: Eat the blood (Leviticus 3:17)

Do: Bleed animals after killing them, and cover the blood on the ground (Leviticus 17:13)

Blood is for: Atonement (Leviticus 17:11) Sealing a covenant (Matthew 26:28, Genesis 15:9-21, Exodus 24:8) Remission of sins (Matthew 26:28, Hebrews 9:22) Justification (Romans 5:9)

Gentiles Abstain From

Things Strangled

30 minutes – coagulation begins

1-2 hours – blood begins to separate into layers

6-12 hours – Fixation: The blood decomposes and leaks into tissues, making the color permanent
