






Theodosius the Great (379-392) made Christianity mandatory

Pagans did not convert to Christianity, they just joined the Church.



Fall Equinox September 22nd




The Earths axis is tilted at 23.5°



The Earths axis is tilted at 23.5°


Earth's axis

We can find Polaris without a compass. Just find the Big Dipper.






It appears that all stars in the heavens revolve around Polaris.



Shimini Atzeret (Leviticus 23:36)

- This 8th day is also Simchat Torah (joy of the Torah [Matthew 5:17-18])


