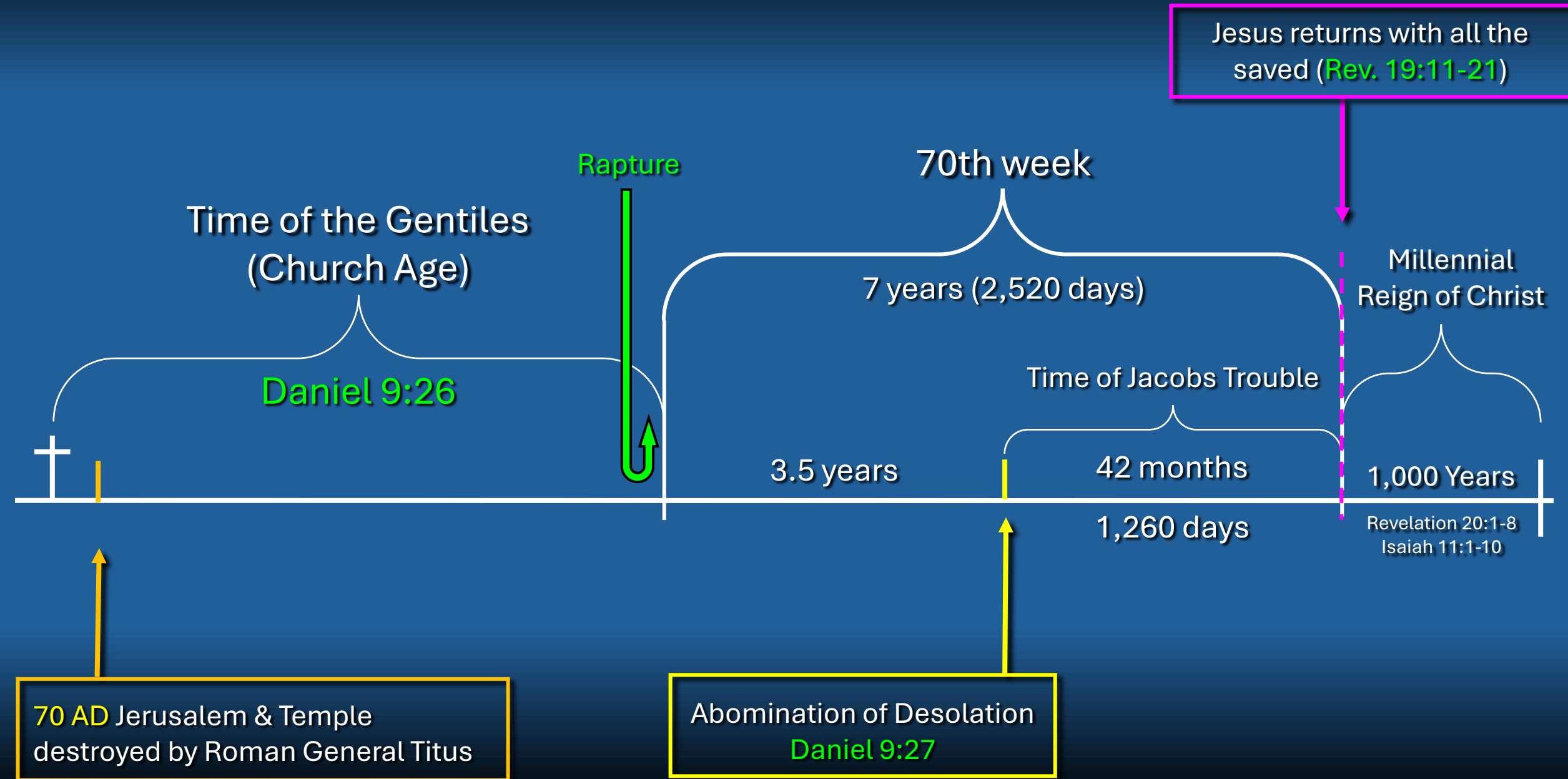

# Glorified Body Facts:

- 1) All the saved will be changed.
- 2) The change will happen instantaneously.
- 3) The change will happen at the last trumpet.
- 4) That event starts with the dead being raised and changed.
- 5) Then we will be changed.

at the last trump: for the trumpet shall

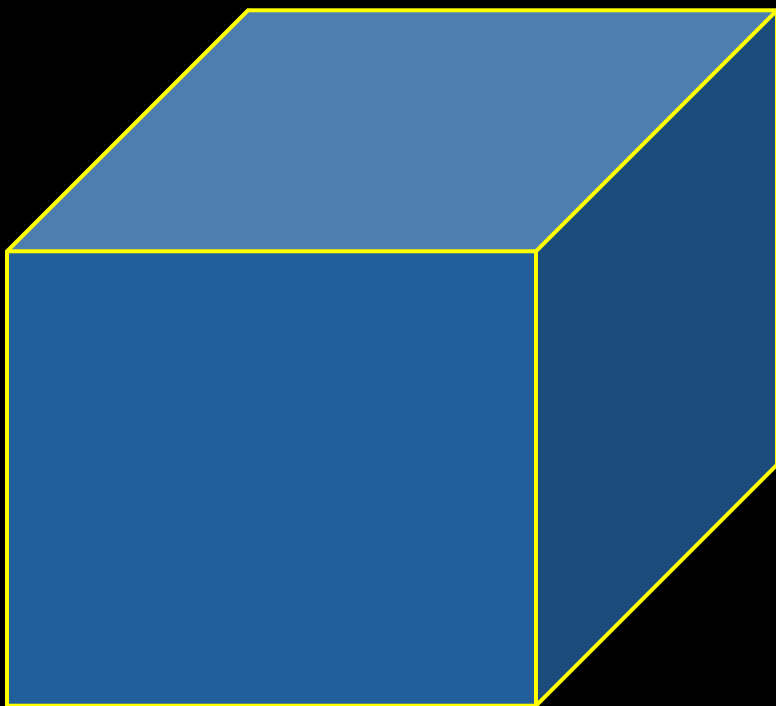

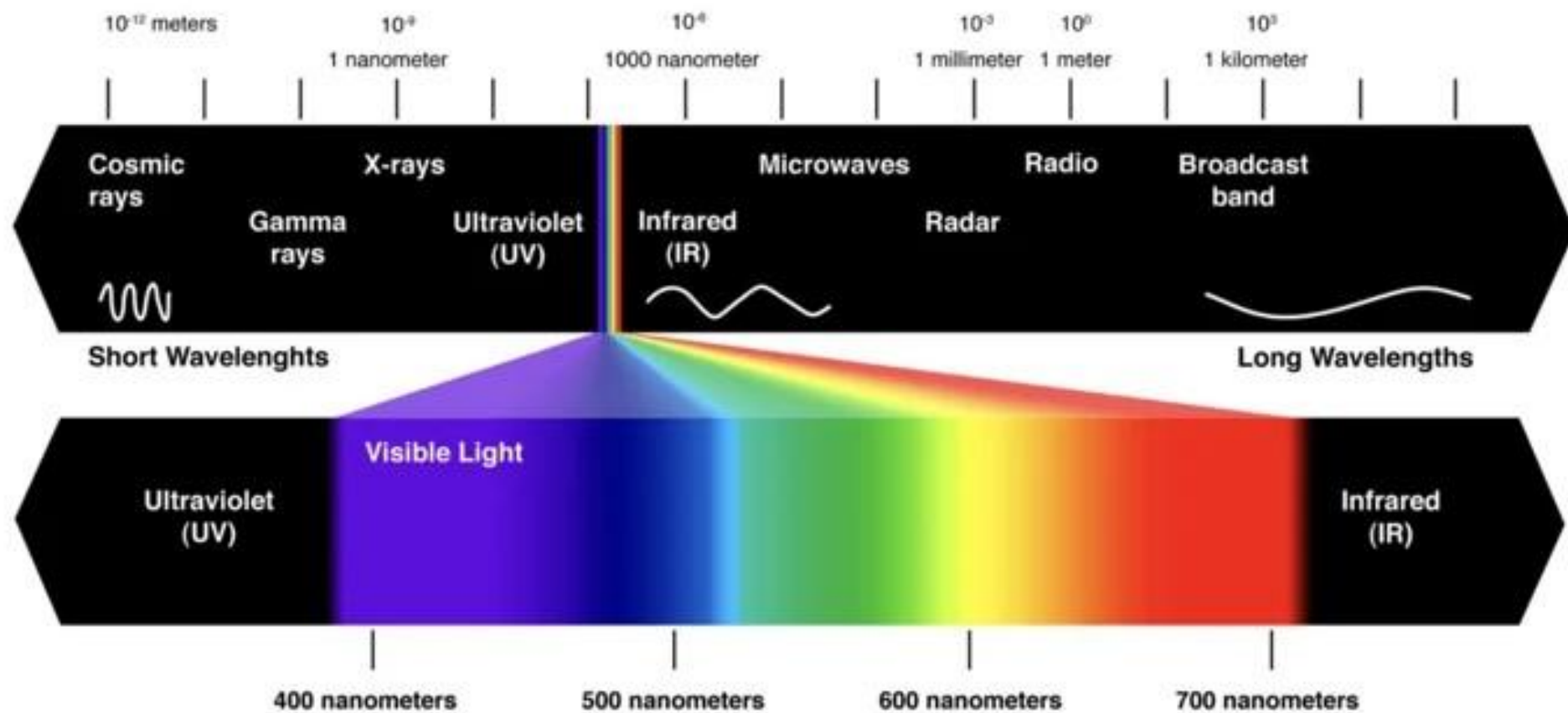

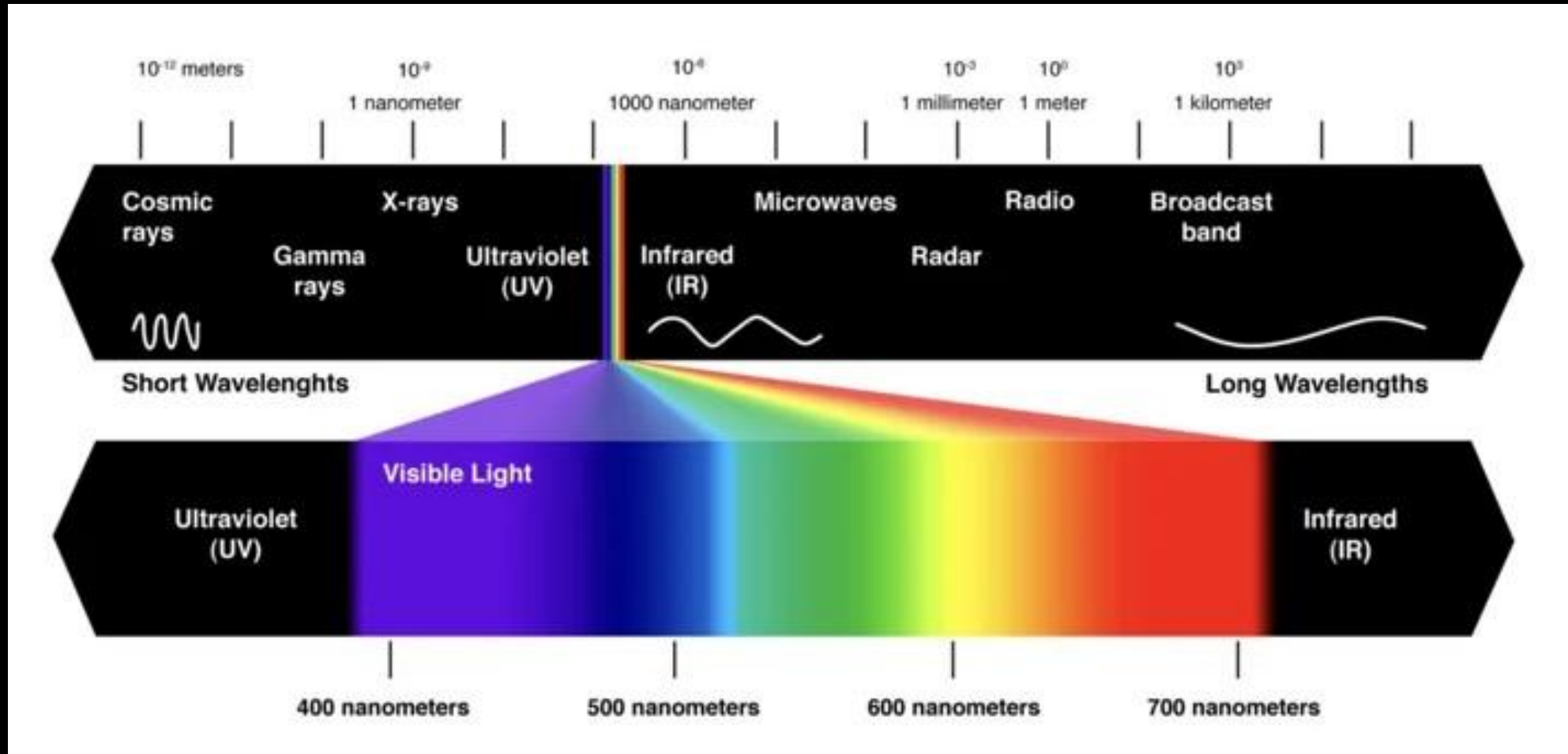

- 6) There is no more death, aging, crying, mourning, sorrow or pain (Revelation 21:4)







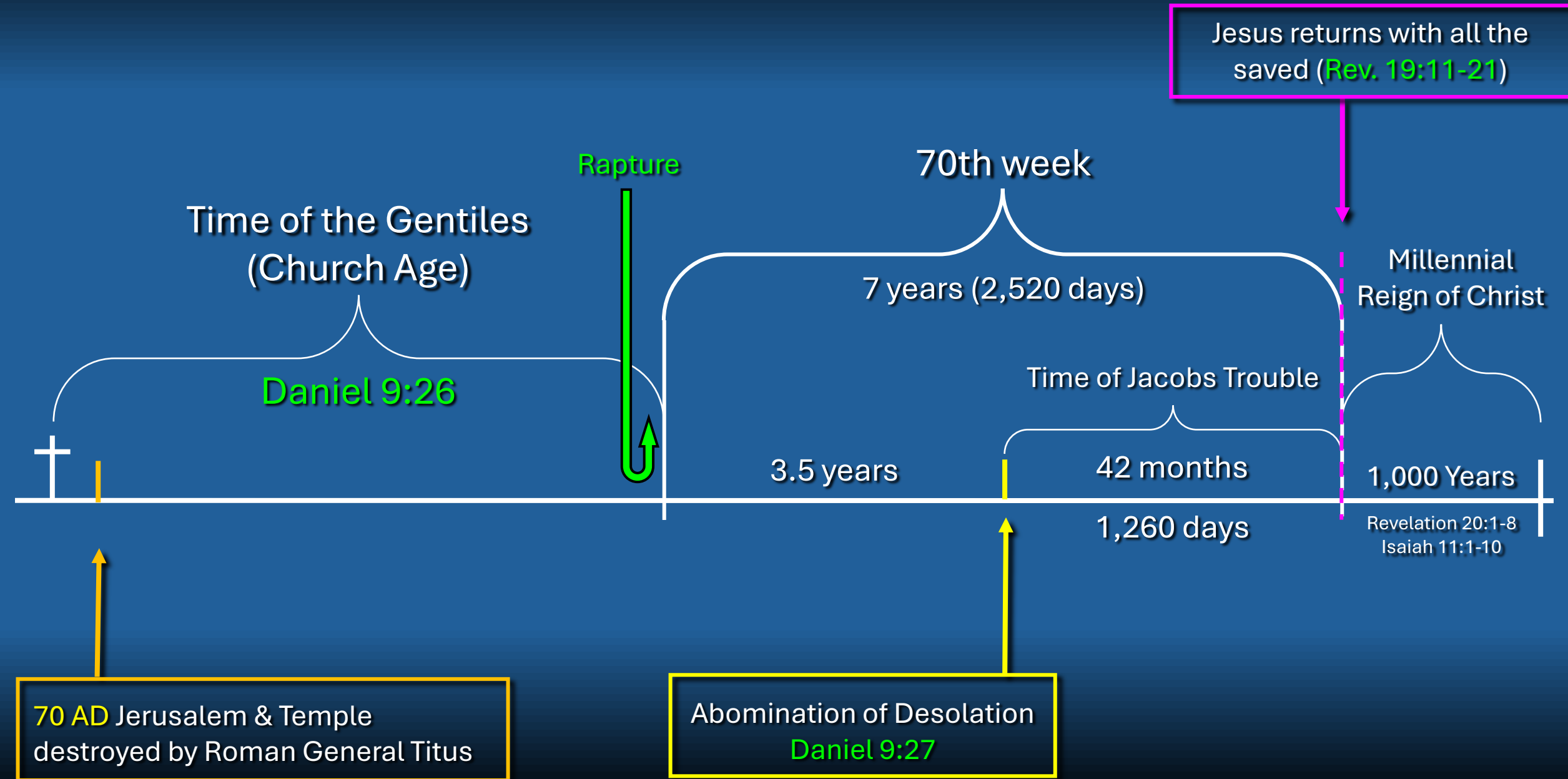

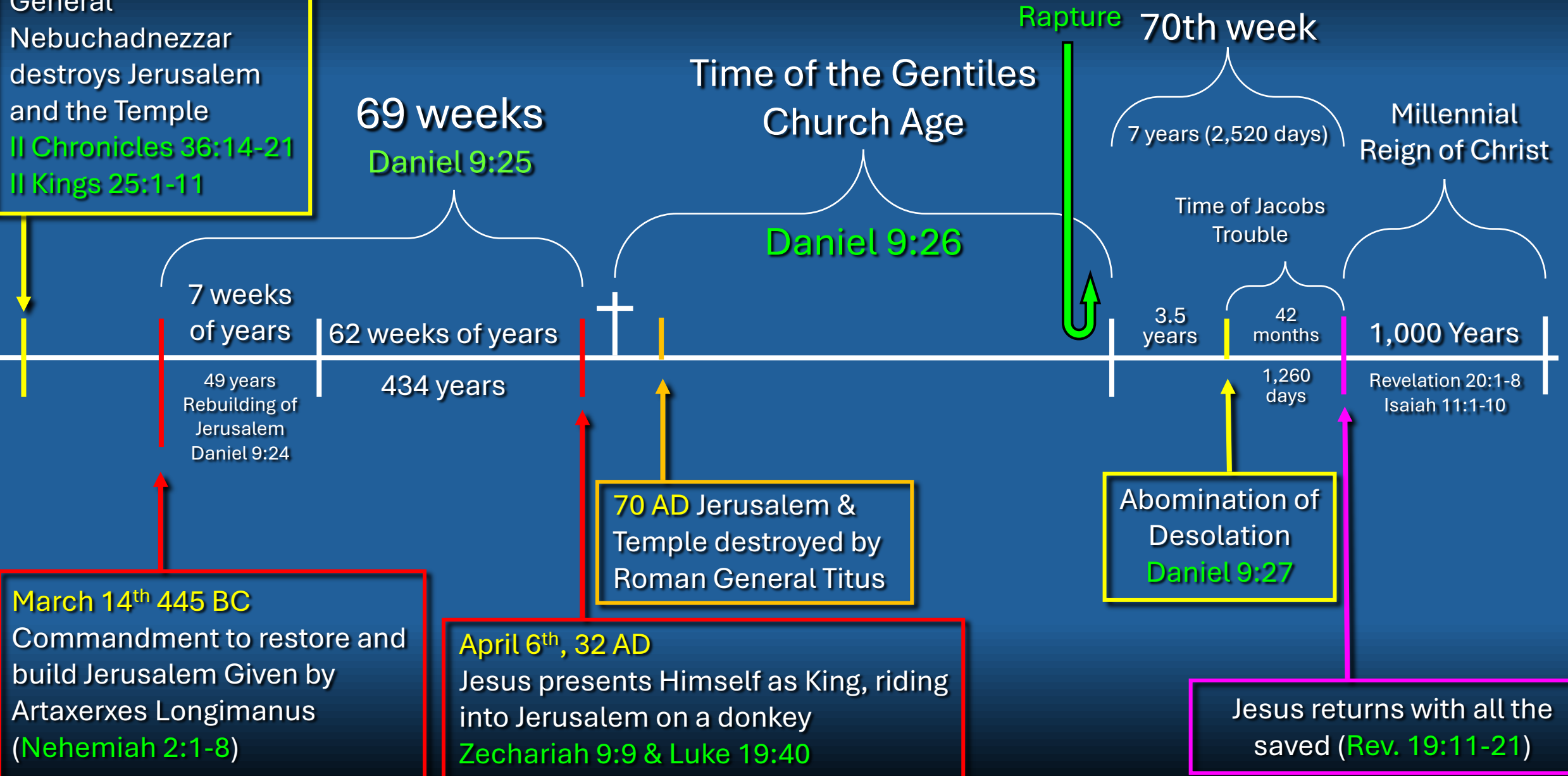


# The Rapture vs. The Day of the Lord

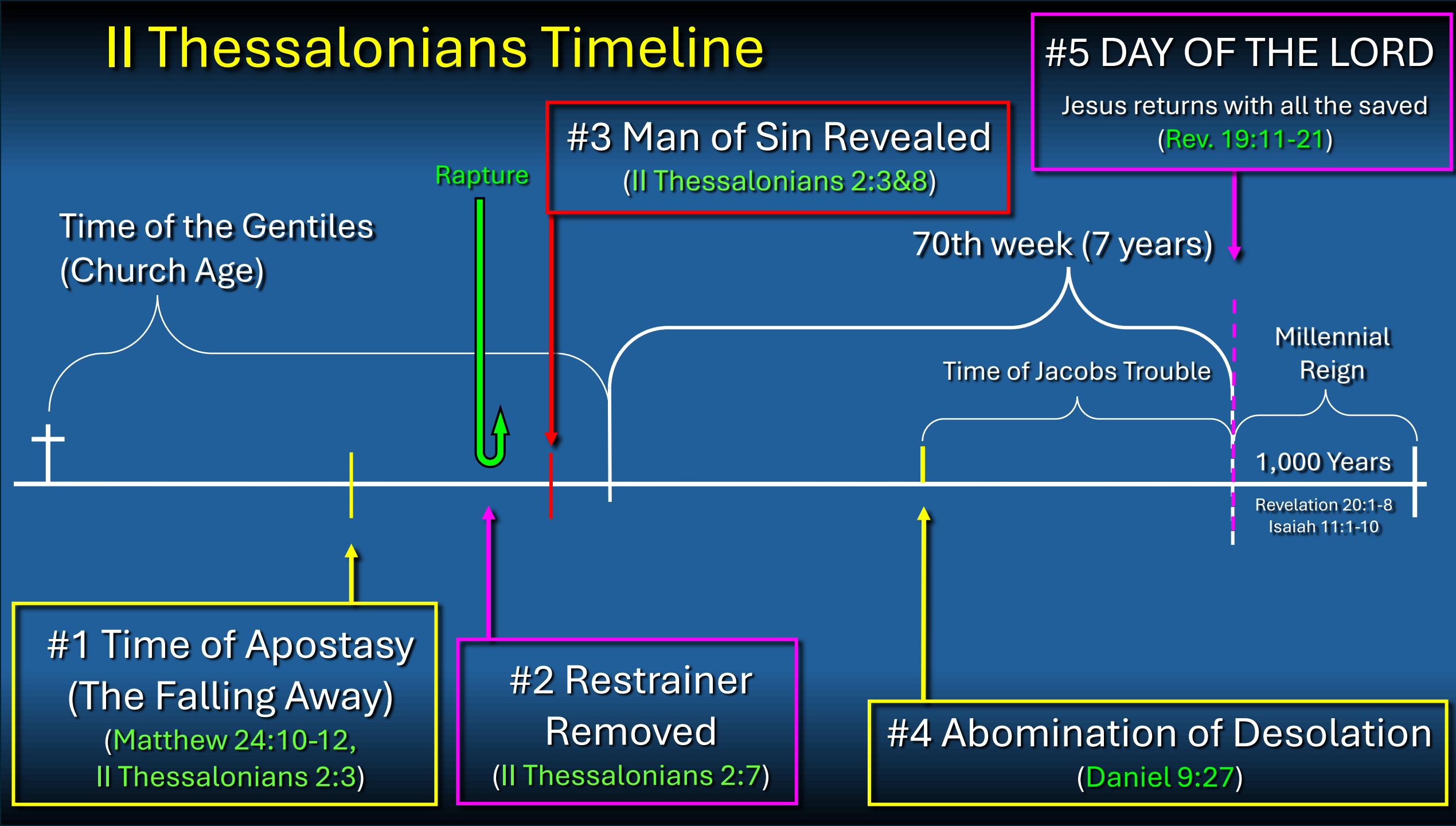

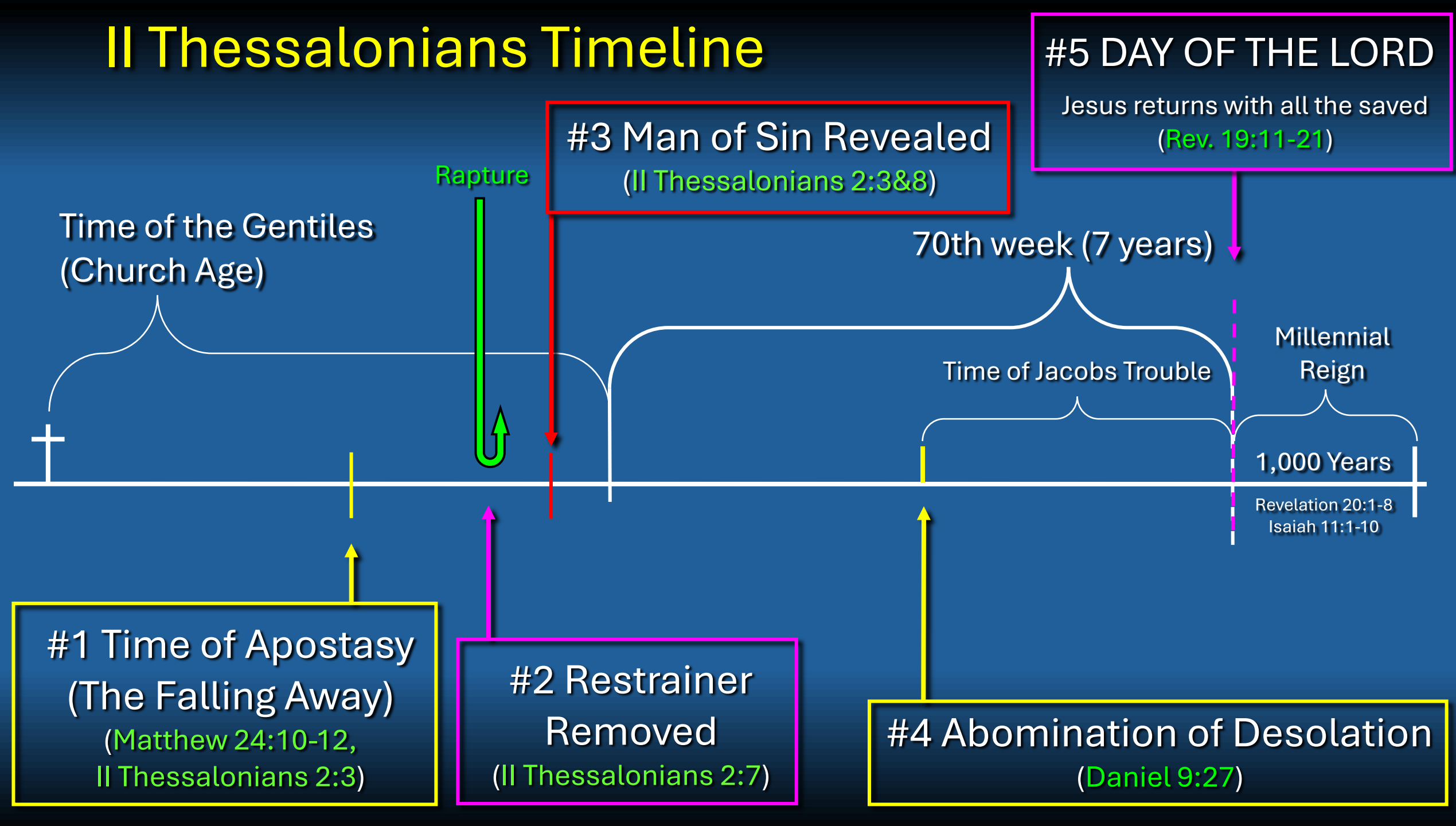


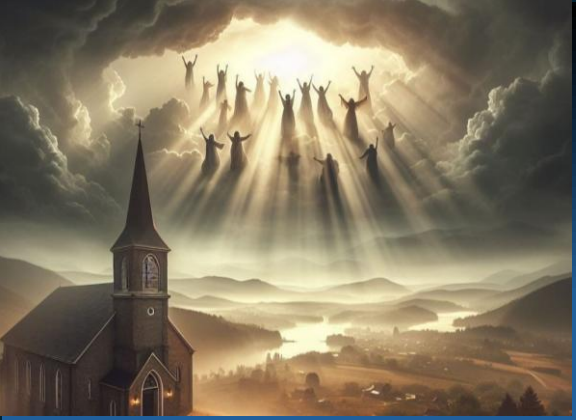

# What will the world look like on the day of the Rapture?

Earth's Population = 8.2 Billion

1/8<sup>th</sup> are children under 7 years old (12.5% or 1 Billion)

10-15% are Christians (12.5%)

213 million women are pregnant (2.5%)

2.3 Billion of people will disappear or die (28%)
