What will the world look like on the day of the Rapture?

Earth's Population = 8.2 Billion

- 1/8th are children under 7 years old (12.5% or 1 Billion)
- 10-15% are Christians (12.5%) 213 million women are pregnant (2.5%)
- 2.3 Billion of people will disappear or die (28%)
