The Bottomless Pit (Abouso)

Luke 8:31, Revelation 9, 11:7, 17:8, 20:1-3
Angel of the BP: Apollyon (**Revelation 9:11**)
Satan bound for 1,000 years (**Revelation 20**)
Demon Locust emerge from the BP (**Revelation 9**)

Tartarus (ταρταρώω [II Peter 2:4])

Deepest abyss of Hell. Everlasting Chains under darkness.
Fallen angels that left their first estate are currently there (**Jude 1:6**).
