# Results of Sin for the Christian (Deuteronomy 28:15-68)

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Death (Physical & Spriritual) (Romans 5:12, 6:23 Ezekiel 18:20)

Separation from God (Isaiah 59:2, Eph. 2:1-3, Col. 1:21)

Physical & Mental Suffering (Psalm 38:3, I Corinthians 11:30, Proverbs 14:30, Deuteronomy 28:28)

Financial Ruin (Haggai 1:6, Deuteronomy 28:30-33)

Lack of Heavenly Rewards (I Corinthians 3:12-15)

Addiction to Sin (John 8:34-36)

# Paradigm of Salvation

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**Justification** – (a legal term) God, instantaneously declaring a sinner righteous based solely on the finished work of Christ on the cross and the faith of the sinner in the work of Jesus (Romans 3:24-25; 5:1-2, Galatians 2:16, Ephesians 2:8-9).



# Paradigm of Salvation

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**Sanctification** – the process of transforming into the likeness of Christ (Romans 8:29, II Corinthians 3:18, Colossians 3:10).



# Paradigm of Salvation

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**Justification** – (a legal term) God, instantaneously declaring a sinner righteous based solely on the finished work of Christ on the cross and the faith of the sinner in the work of Jesus ([Romans 3:24-25](#); [5:1-2](#), [Galatians 2:16](#), [Ephesians 2:8-9](#)).

**Sanctification** – the process of transforming into the likeness of Christ ([Romans 8:29](#), [II Corinthians 3:18](#), [Colossians 3:10](#)).

**Glorification** – Obtaining an immortal body, like Jesus, not made of flesh. Freed from the power of sin ([I Corinthians 15:52-54](#), [Philippians 3:21](#), [I John 3:2](#)).
