Besides repentance, **our works also include receiving ordinances, keeping covenants, and serving others.** While **these works are necessary for salvation,** they aren't sufficient.

They are not enough because we can't live perfect lives, but we can do our best to live righteously. By doing so, we invite the Lord's grace into our lives and **qualify for the gift of salvation.**

For by **grace** are ye saved
through **faith**; and that not of
yourselves: it is the gift of God:
9 Not of works, lest any man
should boast.

Ephesians 2:8-9



If your friends ask, “Does your church believe you are saved by grace or works?” you could say, “**We believe that we are saved by grace after all we can do** (see 2 Ne. 25:23). We don’t earn salvation. Heavenly Father and the Savior will bless us with eternal life, through Their grace, **if we do our part**. They have asked us to have faith in Jesus Christ, repent throughout our lives, be baptized and receive other ordinances, and faithfully endure to the end. **If we do that**, we are promised eternal life through the grace of God.”

“Outside the Church there is no salvation”

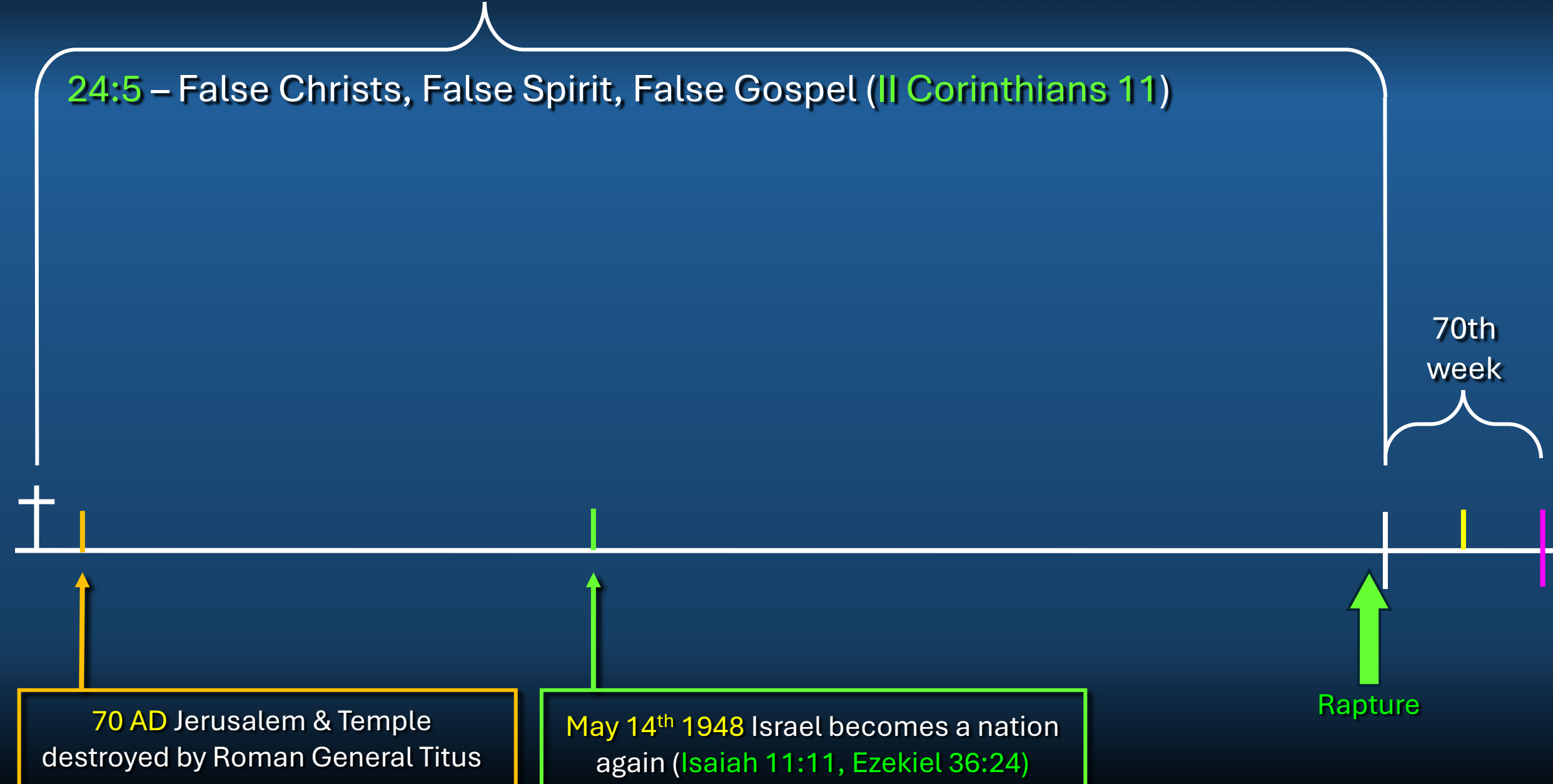
