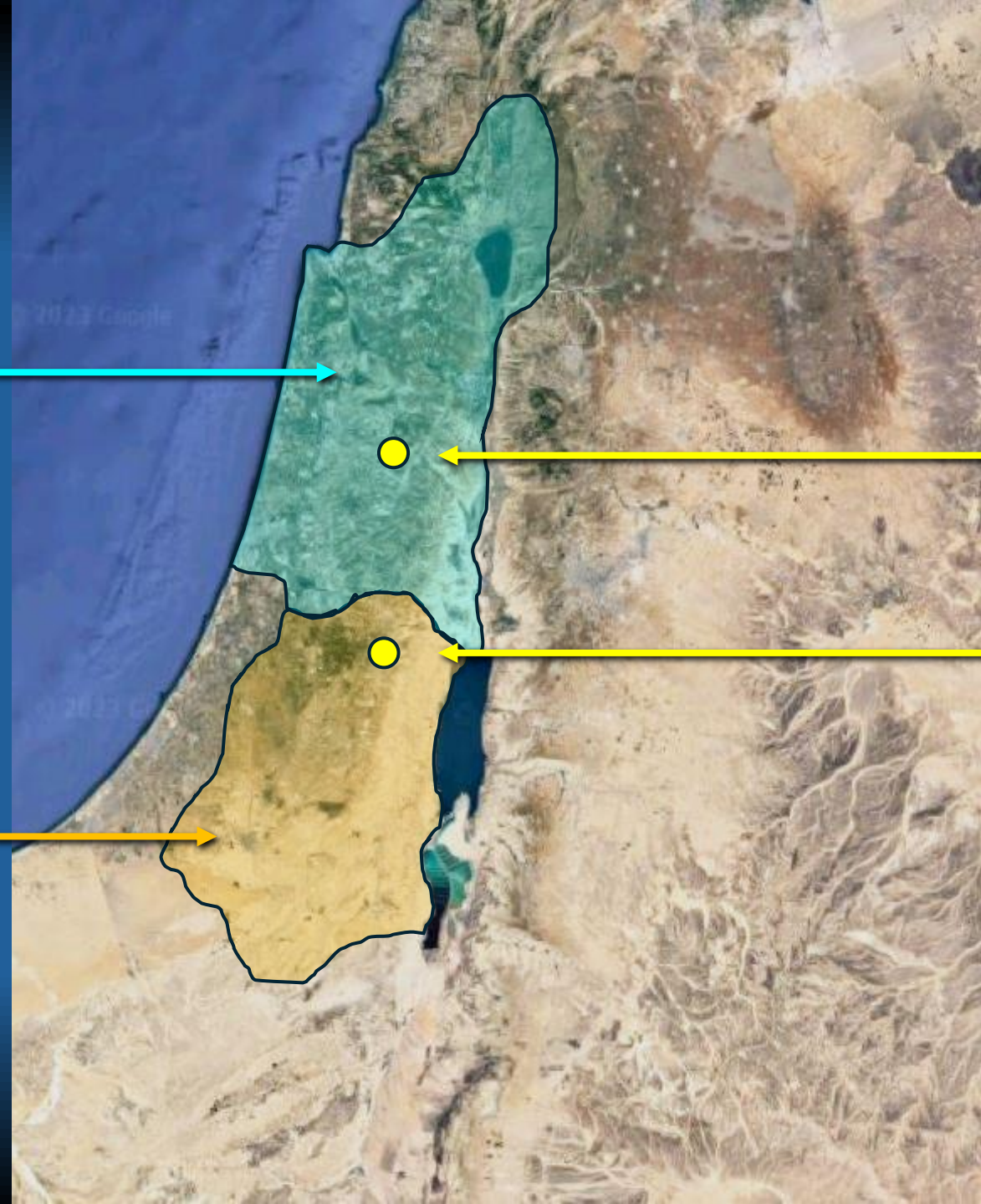

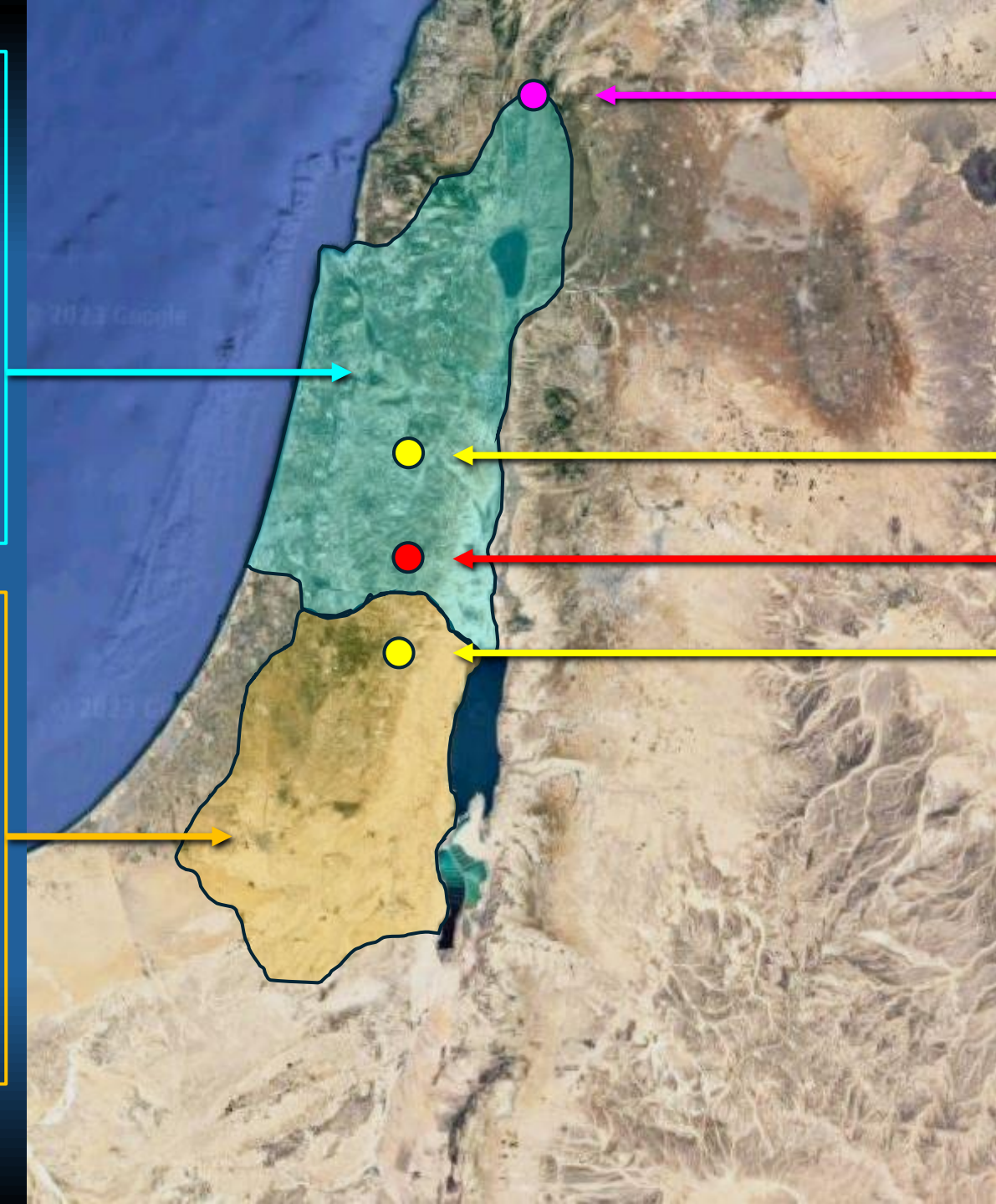

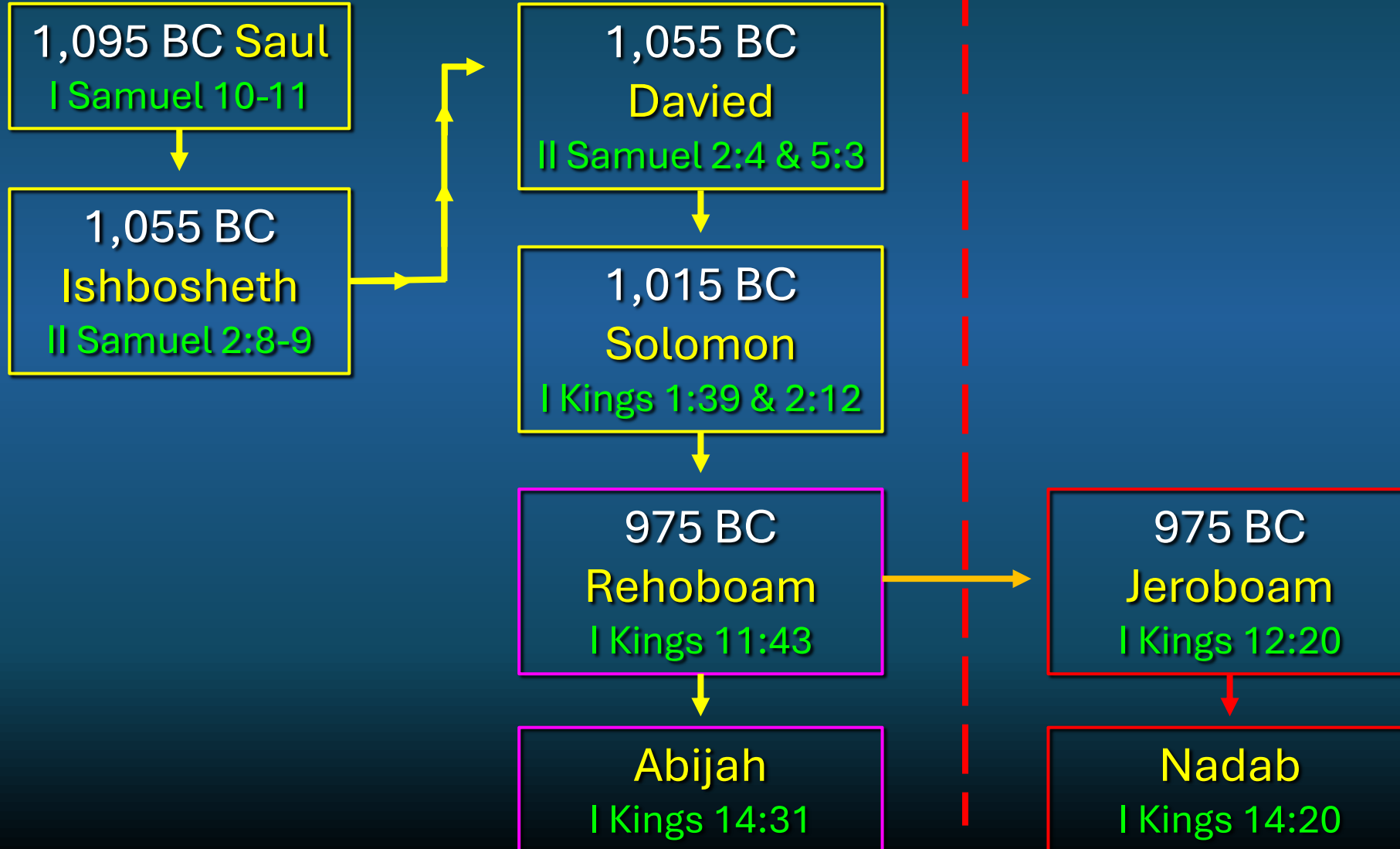

16 **Three times in a year** shall all thy males appear before the Lord thy God in the place which he shall choose; in **the feast of unleavened bread**, and in **the feast of weeks**, and in **the feast of tabernacles**: and they shall not appear before the Lord empty:

27 If this people go up to do sacrifice in the house of the Lord at Jerusalem, then shall the heart of this people turn again unto their lord, even unto Rehoboam king of Judah, and they shall kill me, and go again to Rehoboam king of Judah.

28 Whereupon the king took counsel, and made **two calves of gold**, and said unto them, It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem: **behold thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.**

29 And he set the one in **Bethel**, and the other put he in **Dan**.

30 And this thing became a sin: for the people went to worship before the one, even unto Dan. 31 And he made an house of high places, and **made priests of the lowest of the people, which were not of the sons of Levi.**

32 And Jeroboam **ordained a feast in the eighth month**, on the fifteenth day of the month, like unto the feast that is in Judah, and he offered upon the altar. So did he in Bethel, **sacrificing unto the calves** that he had made: and he placed in Bethel the priests of the high places which he had made.

33 So he offered upon the altar which he had made in Bethel the fifteenth day of the eighth month, even in **the month which he had devised of his own heart**; and ordained a feast unto the children of Israel: and he **offered upon the altar, and burnt incense.**

13 And the priests and the Levites that were
in all Israel resorted to him out of all their
coasts. 14 For the Levites left their suburbs
and their possession, and came to Judah and
Jerusalem: for Jeroboam and his sons had
cast them off from executing the priest's
office unto the Lord:

15 And he ordained him priests for the high places,
and **for the devils**, and **for the calves** which he had
made. 16 And after them **out of all the tribes of
Israel such as set their hearts to seek the Lord God
of Israel came to Jerusalem**, to sacrifice unto the
Lord God of their fathers. V:16 The rest of the
people who wanted to worship God followed the
priests and the Levites.

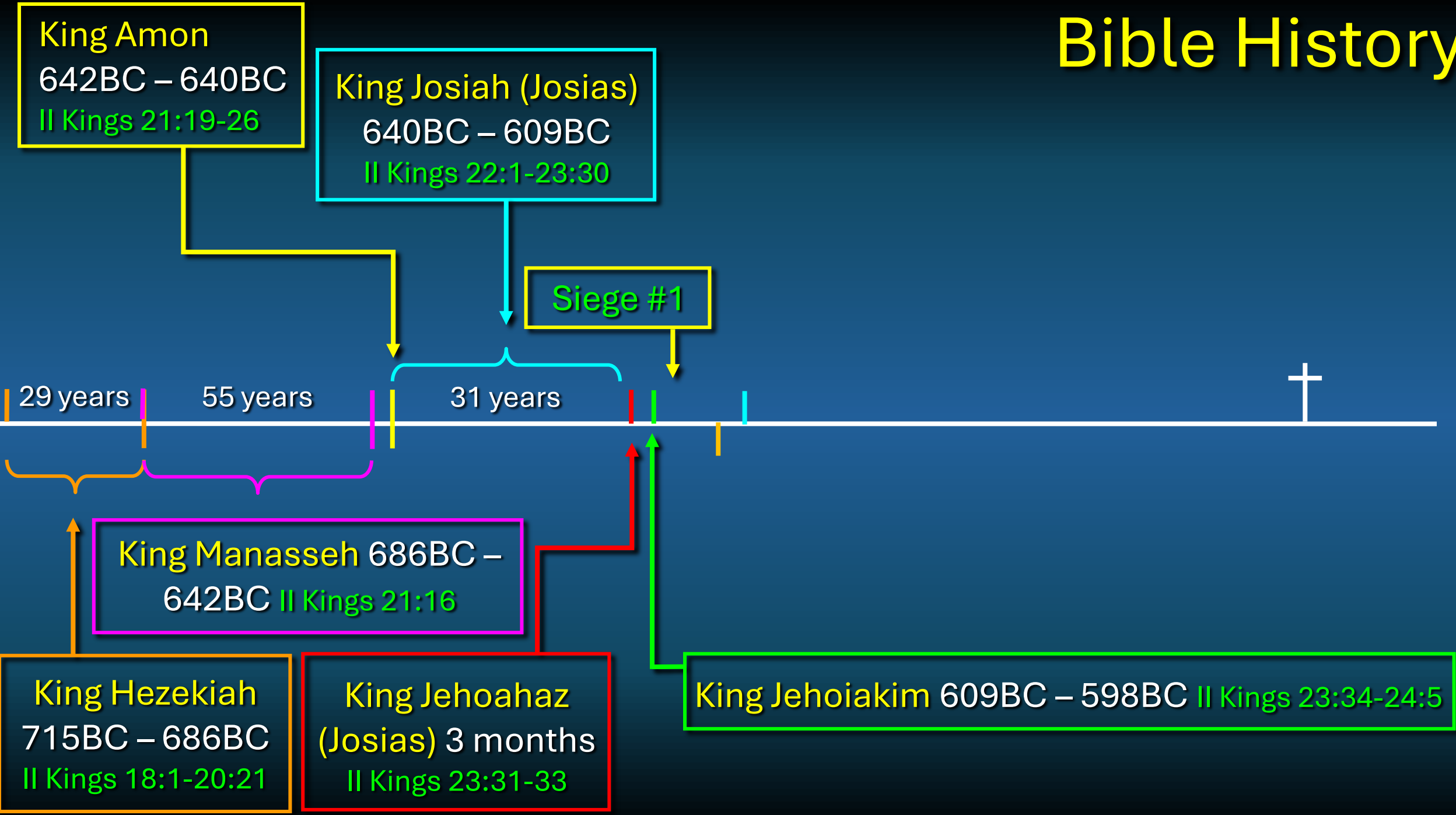
Babylonian Siege of Jerusalem X3



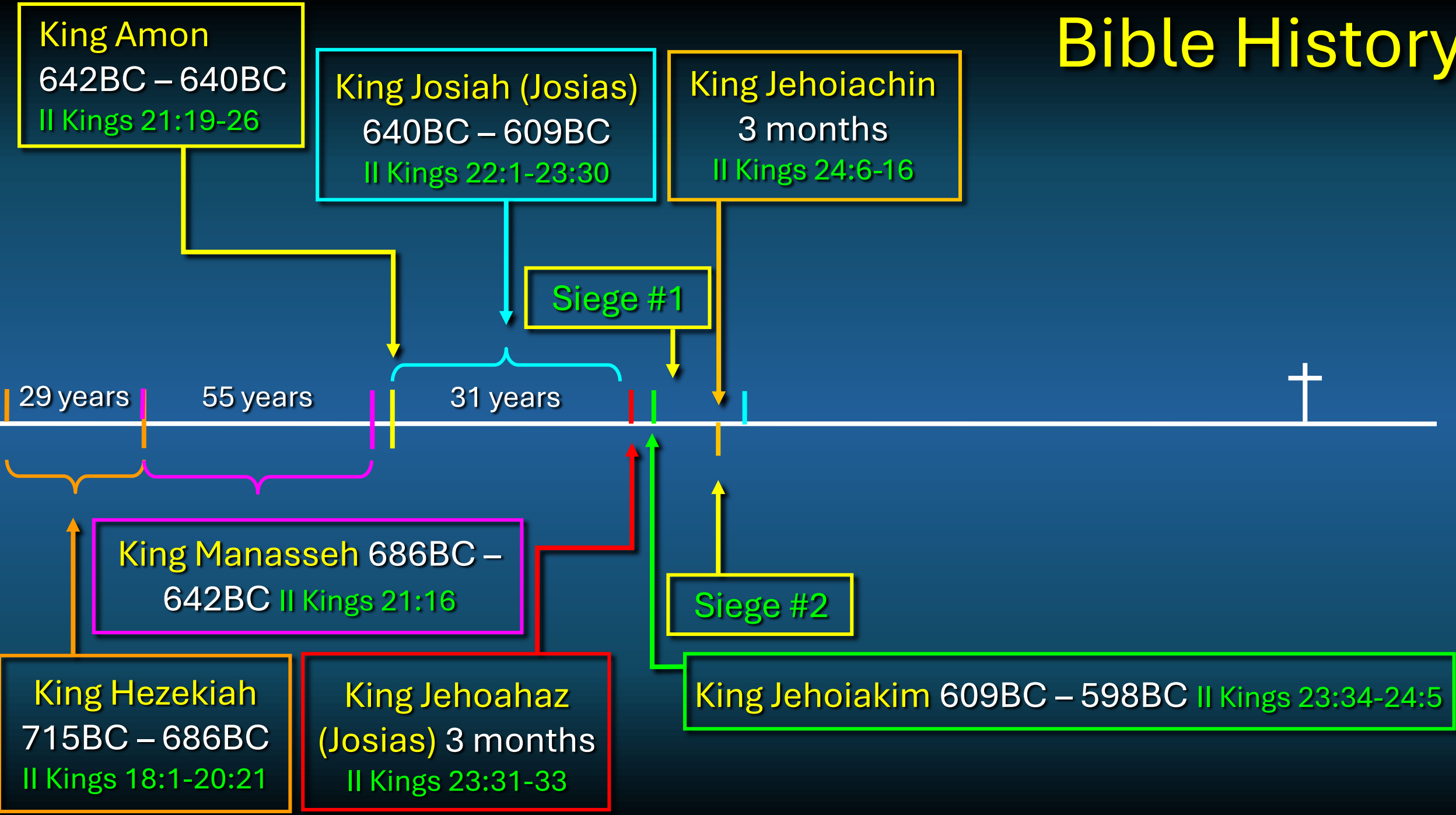
