**** Galatians 5:19-21 NKJV**

Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

He is CLEARLY saying that those who live out these lifestyles... NOT THOSE that have stumbled or fallen into the sinfull

action.... **BUT THOSE WHO PRACTICE** such things..... *will not inherit the kingdom of God.*

To be a Christian... Is to be Christ LIKE

***You cant call yourself a "Christian"**

if you do not live out the "Likeness" of Christ.*

I also added a disclaimer.... I know people were challenged last week..

however..... No **ONE sin** is greater than another in the Eyes of a Holy God.

NOT ONE OF US, ON OUR OWN, CAN LIVE or **will live** Perfectly....

****Romans 3:21–24** *Every Day Bible New Century Version*

²¹ But God has a way to make people right with him without the law, and he has now shown us that way which the law and the prophets told us about. ²² God makes people right with himself through their faith in Jesus Christ. This is true for all who believe in Christ, because all people are the same: ²³ **Everyone has sinned and fallen short of God's glorious standard,** ²⁴ and all need to be made right with God by his

grace, which is a free gift. They need to be made free from sin through Jesus Christ.

EVERYONE has sinned....

So if you are are struggeling... NO... *I know there is an area that you atre struggeling with...*

Whatever THAT area is that you are struggeling with.... IN CHRIST.. There is now NO CONDEMNATION...

NO CONDEMNATION

Does that mean you can continue life justifying your carnal pleasures like you have a licsence to sin??

NO!!!! of course not...

God offers us a New Nature in Christ...

****2 Corinthians 5:16-17** NKJV

Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. 17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.



The word kainos is used in three senses in the New Testament. The act of creating

Grk: Kainos Brand SPANKING NEW!!!

The Rabbins used the word of a man converted from idolatry. "He who brings a foreigner and makes him a proselyte is as if he created him."

Paul was DRIVING the point... a man is not "Created" by conversion.... He's CREATED NEW by *TRANSFORMATION*

in Christ Refers to being in union with Christ through the Holy Spirit; those who believe in Christ participate in His death *and resurrection*.

Behold. As if contemplating a rapidly shifting scene. As in a flash, old things vanish, and all things become new.

new creation Believers are transformed in Christ as part of God's renewal of *all creation*

****Romans 8:19–23** NKJV

¹⁹ For the earnest expectation of *the creation* eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. ²⁰ *For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope;* ²¹ because *the creation* itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious

liberty of the children of God. ²² For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now. ²³ Not only *that*, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.

All of CREATION is in a fallen state of brokenness crying out with us for the redemption & renewal of our state.

****2 Co 3:17–18** NKJV

¹⁸ But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

from glory into glory Paul suggests that believers will progress through ever-greater degrees of glory

doxa in Greek; This may mean that they will learn and grow more in their relationship with Him over time. Alternatively, this progress may begin with the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit and culminate in the transformation of the physical body into a glorious one

Progressive Sanctification

I'm a work in progress!

When we receive CHRIST... We slowly begin to die to sin, & live towards righteousness.

**Romans 6:1–14 NKJV

6 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? ² Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it? ³ Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? ⁴ Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

⁵ For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be *in the likeness* of His resurrection, ⁶ knowing this, that our old man was crucified with *Him*, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. ⁷ For he who has died has been freed from sin. ⁸ Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, ⁹ knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. ¹⁰ For *the death* that He died, He died to sin once for all; but *the life* that He lives, He lives to God.

¹¹ Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

¹² Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. ¹³ And do not present your members *as* instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members *as* instruments of righteousness to God. ¹⁴ For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

& what was that Grace that God gave us?? That thing that we do not deserve?

*The Lamb of God Who takes the sin of the world!
NOT just US ... But ALL of Creation.*

How do we receive Jesus??

****VIDEO** "IT MATTERS" - Communion

For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this,

whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.
