We can Find Eternal Peace in Jesus, who has Overcome the World.

Isaiah 9:1-7

¹ But there will be no gloom for her who was in anguish. In the former time he brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the latter time he has made glorious the way of the

sea, the land beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations.

The people who walked in darkness

have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone.

You have multiplied the nation;

you have increased its joy; they rejoice before you

as with joy at the harvest,

as they are glad when they divide the spoil.

For the yoke of his burden,
and the staff for his shoulder,

the rod of his oppressor,
you have broken as on the day of Midian.
For every boot of the tramping warrior in battle

ADVENT

Advent is a reminder, a time of preparation and anticipation of the coming of Christ. The Bible speaks of the long foretold life, death, resurrection and coming judgement of Christ. Christmas is the season of celebrating what has come, is and will be because of the person of Christ. The traditional themes are Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love. This guide expands on these themes using the patriarchs, prophets, persons and means of preparation, and acts of love fulfilled perfectly in Christ.

PEACE

We find peace in trusting in the words of God. Prophecy has been the means of revealing God's word, until the Word came and revealed all things. People did not listen, did not understand and did not believe. The span of prophecy regarding Christ's life, death and resurrection is almost 4,000 years -- from the first message to its fulfillment, and
