

Dinner Table Questions

Below are some questions about last Sunday's lesson. You can discuss these in at dinner, before bed, or even in the car on the way to practice!

HOW WAS PETER ABLE TO COURAGEOUSLY FACE PRISON AND EVEN CERTAIN DEATH?

REMIND KIDS THAT PETER BELIEVED WHAT HE PREACHED: ALL THOSE WHO TRUST IN JESUS ARE FORGIVEN OF THEIR SINS AND WILL LIVE WITH HIM FOREVER. TELL KIDS THAT THE TRUTH OF THE GOSPEL GIVES US BOLDNESS AND COURAGE TO FACE DIFFICULT CIRCUMSTANCES BECAUSE JESUS HAS RESCUED US FROM ETERNAL PUNISHMENT.

HAT IF GOD DOES NOT ANSWER OUR PRAYERS AS WE HOPE

Discuss how James was also arrested but God chose not to rescue him from death. Tell kids that God's wisdom and plans are far beyond our understanding. Remind kids that following Jesus means trusting Him even when our prayers are not answered as we hope, knowing that one day everything will be made right.

HOW CAN YOU BE PRAYING FOR OTHERS? WHO DO YOU KNOW THAT NEEDS PRAYER?

ANSWERS WILL VARY. DISCUSS HOW EVERYONE NEEDS PEOPLE PRAYING FOR THEM. DISCUSS HOW WE CAN PRAY FOR PEOPLE'S NEEDS, BUT THAT WE SHOULD ALSO PRAY FOR PEOPLE'S SPIRITUAL GROWTH. REMIND KIDS THAT GOD HEARS OUR PRAYERS AND THAT AS WE PRAY WE GROW CLOSER TO HIM.
