How God has led us—step by step—into this moment.



# Our Response

**GOD IS MOVING

For forty years, God has blessed Park Chapel and guided our steps. We've seen His faithfulness in every season—through growth, challenge, renewal, and mission. We are here today because the Lord has been with us, and He has provided—again and again.

**MOVE** is our response to God's ongoing work among us. It's a step of faith, unity, and generosity—because we believe the Gospel is worth building for, and the next generation is worth preparing for.

## **NOT A NEW ADDRESS, JUST A BIGGER VISION**

We're not moving locations—we're moving forward. **MOVE** will expand and enhance our campus to better serve the people God is bringing to Park Chapel now—and those He will bring in the future. These are not just building improvements. They are ministry environments—designed for life change, Gospel conversations, and generational discipleship.

This initiative will create and improve spaces such as:

- A remodeled worship center
- A dedicated kids' wing
- A community indoor playground
- Basketball gyms and community gathering environments
- Additional areas that support discipleship, connection, and ministry throughout the week

## WHY THIS MATTERS NOW

We are currently at—or beyond—capacity in key environments on Sundays and throughout the week, especially in children's ministry, student ministry, and gathering spaces.

**MOVE** is not about building bigger for the sake of building bigger. It's about removing barriers to ministry so more people can encounter Jesus, grow in discipleship, and find a church family.

This project is about creating environments where:

- Children learn the Gospel in safe, engaging spaces
- Students build faith and identity in community
- Families connect, grow, and belong
- People far from God feel welcomed and invited

# The Plan

## **TWO PHASES. ONE VISION.**

**MOVE** will be completed in two phases—allowing Park Chapel to address the most pressing needs first while moving forward responsibly and faithfully.

### **Timing**

Construction timelines will depend on the pace of giving and the completion of Phase 1 funding. Our desire is to move forward as soon as resources allow—without borrowing.

Total construction is estimated at approximately 18 months for both phases.



## PHASE 1 // \$7.5 MILLION

Phase 1 focuses on environments used every week by children, families, and the congregation:

- New and expanded kids ministry environments (first and second floors)
- Indoor playground for our community
- A new student ministry center
- A redesigned lobby to improve flow and connection
- A dedicated connector corridor
- Renovation to convert offices into kids space
- Security, signage, furnishings, equipment, and key infrastructure updates
- Expanded outreach storage capacity
- Updated and expanded office suite





## PHASE 2 // \$5 MILLION

Phase 2 expands additional environments needed to serve the church and community throughout the week:

- Worship center conversion: current gym renovated to one shared worship venue (with continued variety in worship gatherings for all generations)
- Construction of two gym courts and additional community spaces
- Kitchen and concession stand facilities
- Multipurpose environments
- Storage for equipment

# The Goal

Building for the Gospel and for the Generations, a two-year initiative to prepare Park Chapel for the next forty years.

## THE FINANCIAL GOAL

All-At-Once Build:

**\$11.5 million**

Cash already raised:

**\$2 million**

Two Phased Approach:

Phase 1: \$7.5 million

### A Debt-Free Desire

Our prayerful desire is to move forward without borrowing. Building debt-free means future resources can go to ministry—not interest payments—and it positions Park Chapel for long-term health and flexibility.

## HOW MOVE IS FUNDED

Park Chapel uses a One Fund model for generosity. This means all giving goes into one unified ministry fund—supporting the mission of Park Chapel with integrity, clarity, and unity.

### ○ Step 1: Fully Fund the Annual Ministry Budget

Before any resources are released toward **MOVE**, we first fully fund Park Chapel's annual ministry budget of \$2.5 million. This protects the strength of everyday ministry—weekend services, next-gen programs, local outreach, global missions, staffing, care, and discipleship.

### ○ Step 2: Additional Generosity Fuels **MOVE**

After the yearly ministry budget is fully supported, all additional generosity goes toward **MOVE**—funding Phase 1, preparing for Phase 2, and building long-term ministry environments for children, students, families, and community outreach.

## WHAT RAISING \$10.5 MILLION LOOKS LIKE

**MOVE** is not just a giving initiative—it's a spiritual journey. God is inviting every person and every family to take part. An opportunity to respond with gratitude, obedience, and faith. Your commitment is a faith-filled estimate, not a legal contract. If circumstances change, you can adjust at any time.

**MOVE** commitments represent a two-year giving intention. These figures illustrate how a combination of gifts—large and small—can lead us to our overall goal. The total project need after current funds is \$10.5 million. This is a representative model showing how this amount can be reached through a wide range of commitments.

## MEANINGFUL WAYS TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS SEASON OF GENEROSITY

### ○ APPRECIATED ASSETS

Consider transferring appreciated assets (real estate, stocks, business equity, etc.) as a way to maximize giving impact while reducing tax burden.

### ○ SALE OF ASSETS

Designate a portion of proceeds from selling personal or business assets.

### ○ SAVINGS & INVESTMENTS

Use a portion of savings, bonuses, investment returns, or accumulated reserves.

### ○ DELAYED EXPENDITURES

Postpone or reduce non-essential purchases for a season to increase generosity.

### ○ INCOME-PRODUCING ASSETS

Give rental income, business profit, or earnings from side ventures.

### ○ INCOME & SACRIFICE

Give a percentage above your regular support, or consider increasing your ongoing giving for the next two years.
