1

Read Colossians 3:23 with a friend or family member. Read it out loud again, but this time, leave out a few words as you say it. Take turns, and see if you or your partner can fill in the missing words.

KNOW that what you do for others, you are also doing for God.

4

Hands and Hearts

Ask God to help you use what you have been given by using your own prayer or the prayer below.

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 “Dear God, thank You for giving us hands to help and hearts to care. Please help us notice ways to help others and to use what You’ve given us to make the world better. Thank You for trusting us to do good things for You. Amen.”
