Head (Knowledge) – What did you learn?

About God -

What did you learn about God? God's character? God's purposes? God's plan of redemption? God's Church?

About Others & the World -

What does this passage teach about the dignity of human nature?

What does this passage teach about the deprayity of human nature?

What does this passage teach about living in a fallen world?

About Yourself -

What spiritual condition was in the passage that you share in common with the original audience?

Heart (Conviction/Affection) – What did the Holy Spirit move or stir within you?

Conviction -

What of your beliefs were affected by the truth of this passage?

Affections -

How does the truth of this passage encourage, challenge, and/or redirect the affections of your heart towards greater love and obedience to Christ?

Hands (Trust) – In dependence on the Holy Spirit, how will you seek to live as a result of this passage?

Identify -

What does God now require of you? Where does he require it of you? Why must you do what he requires?

Brainstorm -

How can you do what God requires? (In word, thought, and actions).

How can your church family help you do what God requires?

Pray -

Praise God for who He has revealed himself to be. Confess your inability to live out this passage in your own strength.

Thank the Lord for his forgiveness, provision, and grace found in Jesus.

Ask the Lord for his power to change your heart and enable you to faithfully live according to the truth revealed in his Word.
