2. What is the significance of the Messiah's birth in Bethlehem? How does this show the extent to which the family of David had suffered?
3. What did it look like, over the course of the remainder of the Old Testament history of God's people, for the LORD to "give them up" (verse 3)?
4. Even after the return from exile, what did God's people continually lack? Why was their restoration incomplete?
5. Why was Jesus a greater deliverer than Moses?
6. Why is it significant that the promised ruler to come should "shepherd" God's people?
7. How will it come to pass that God's people shall possess both security and peace? Who will provide it?
8. In what ways has Micah's prophesy been fulfilled, and in what ways does it wait for a further fulfillment to come?
