7. What must you acknowledge about the world and yourself in order to feel your need for the light? What will happen if you refuse to acknowledge this truth?
8. In what circumstances or areas of life do you seek guidance? Do you do so in your spiritual life? Why or why not?
9. If Jesus provides water, bread, shelter, light, and sure guidance to an eternal home, what else do you need?
10. What will be absent in your eternal home? What will that mean for those who "loved the darkness" (John 3:19)?
11. If you follow Jesus, what sure confidence does Colossians 1:13-14 give you?
