3. Without naming names or churches, have you seen ministry that is marked more by discord and disagreement, than by synergy? What did it look like and what were its effects?
4. Work for the kingdom of God is destined to succeed. How is this a comfort to you as you labor in God's kingdom?
5. Why is it crucial that kingdom work be grounded in Scripture?
6. Review these themes from the Colossian sermon series. How are they an aid to your faith in Christ and your work for God?
 - a. You are to give thanks for salvation (1:1-8)
 - b. You are to pray for one another (1:9-14)
 - c. Jesus is Lord of creation and the Church (1:15-20)
 - d. Jesus supplies every need (1:21-23)
 - e. Christ is in you (1:24-29)
 - f. You are to struggle for believers to trust and walk in Christ (2:1-7)
 - g. You are to ignore the falsehood of the world, and to learn the truth of Christ (2:8-15)
 - h. Christ is the substance of salvation (2:16-19)
 - i. Worldly rules have no wisdom or power (2:20-23)
 - j. Your life is already and not yet with Christ (3:1-4)
 - k. You are to put ungodliness to death (3:5-11)
 - l. You are to put on Christ-likeness (3:12-17)
 - m. You are to honor the Lord in your relationships (3:18-4:1)
 - n. You are to pray with resolve and for results (4:2-4)
 - o. You are to walk and talk as a witness with outsiders (4:5-6)
 - p. You are work for kingdom of God with his workers and by his word (4:7-18)
