- 3. What characteristic is required to receive Jesus as your king?
- 4. How has humility helped you in coming to know Jesus? How has it helped you to grow as a disciple of Jesus?
- 5. What comfort does knowing that your King humbled himself, bring to you?
- 6. What areas of your life that are difficult to let Jesus be king over? Why is that? Take a moment to share and pray for one another.
- 7. What did the Jews presume about Jesus? What kind of actions and speech revealed their presumption?
- 8. How might you or Christians today be tempted to presume upon King Jesus? Are there any "Romans" that we think Jesus must deliver us from today?
- 9. Do you see your need to receive Jesus on his terms rather than your own? Why or why not?
- 10. Spend time in prayer thanking God for coming as the Messiah to deliver God's people from sin and death. Ask God to help you receive Jesus on his terms rather than on your terms or someone else's.
