- 5. Do you see your need to be shepherded? In what ways have you been shepherded in the past that have been a blessing for you?
- 6. How can you help people to see who they are worshiping/being shepherded by?
- 7. How are you individually participating in the work of your Good Shepherd?
- 8. How is your Community Group participating in His work?
- 9. How might we as a church grow in our participation?
- 10. How can you pursue further unity in the one flock?
- 11. What comfort does it bring you to know that the Good Shepherd has the authority over all his undershepherds and that they are accountable to him? Does your shepherding efforts reflect his way of shepherding?
- 12. How might you thank and encourage and pray for your undershepherds and your shepherding efforts?
