

- 1. Reread Micah 1:1-2:5. What "things" in 2:6 do the false preachers want Micah not to preach?
- 2. In v.6, why do the false preachers think Micah should stop preaching?
- 3. Read Proverbs 15:12 and 17:10. Do you remember disliking a warranted reproof, or being hard-hearted to a warranted rebuke? What was the result? If appropriate, share with the group.
- 4. What does v.11 reveal about the desires of the people and the false preachers' willingness to meet them?
- 5. Why are the LORD's words of judgment "good to him who walks uprightly?" (v.7)
- 6. Besides the seesaw illustration, how else can you explain the relationship between God's mercy/grace and wrath/judgment?
- 7. Greed drove the sin in vv.8-9. What do you learn from Hebrews 10:34 that must drive your generosity?
- 8. Read John 5:24-29, and rejoice that Christ endured the wrath of God so that we receive the mercy of God!
