SCRIPTURE: Luke 15:20-32



### **OPENING QUESTIONS**

- 1. How have you been affected by the birth order in your family?
- 2. What was your favorite thing you did this summer?

#### IN THE WORD

- 1. Read Luke 15:11-20. How would you summarize what the younger son did? What have you heard about this part of the parable in the past?
- 2. Explain why Luke 15:1-2 is so important in understanding the parable.
- 3. Why do we usually stop with Luke 15:20-27? What is the message up to this point in the parable?
- 4. What makes the older brother as lost as the younger brother according to Luke 15:28-32?

#### MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Explain what is meant by the terms "moral conformity" and "self-discovery" as used in the sermon regarding this parable.
- 2. What does it mean to do the right thing, but still be guilty of the sin of self-righteousness?
- 3. Give an example of an older brother that you have in your life. Did that person understand their imperfection?
- 4. Do you most identify with the older or younger brother? Explain.
- 5. What can you do to improve your own areas of imperfection?

#### CONTINUED LEARNING

Read Romans 7:14-8:4. Paul struggles like all of us; however, he finds out that only Jesus gives the ultimate victory.
