- 2. In what way is the activity of the manager in Luke 16:3 something we should all do?
- 3. Is appears that the manager was stealing from the master in Luke 16:5-7. How would you explain to a person reading this story for the first time why the master would commend the manager for stealing?
- 4. Why do you think Jesus said what He did in Luke 16:8?
- 5. What is Jesus' point in Luke 16:9?
- 6. What surprises you the most in Matthew 10:16?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. What is something you have learned from someone else's bad example?
- 2. How would you explain "Shrewd is not rude" to someone?
- 3. Give an example of what it means to be shrewd as a Christian with your faith.
- 4. Share a way you could use worldly wealth to influence others for eternity.
