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OPENING QUESTIONS

- 1. What is something positive that happened while you were staying home this last week.
- 2. How has the peace of Jesus impacted your life?

IN THE WORD

- Name some specific ways we feel like the disciples in John 20:19.
- 2. What was the reason the women went to the tomb in Matthew 28:1?
- 3. Read Matthew 28:2-7. Explain how each person might have been impacted.
- 4. In what way is Matthew 28:2-7 about freedom both then and today?
- 5. What are some of the implications that Ephesians 1:19-20 has for Christians today?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Where in your life do you need the peace that Jesus offers us?
- 2. How can Jesus "breathing on you" empower you this week?
- 3. What stone can Jesus roll away in your life?

CONTINUED LEARNING

Read through John 20 and consider the impact the resurrection had on each person you read about. This week, share about the resurrection and the impact it has had on you with someone in your life.
