- 2. Even in the midst of a death as seen in Luke 12:13, why do we believe greed can rear its ugly head?
- 3. According to Luke 12:16-19, does the rich man do anything wrong? Is it wrong to save or expand a business?
- 4. Explain the plot twist in verses 20-21. What is Jesus really saying here?
- 5. Read Mark 8:36 and tell how this verse can encourage us overcome greed.

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Is it so difficult to see greed in your own life or is it just difficult to admit it?
- 2. How can greed destroy joy in a person's life?
- 3. In what ways does choosing consumption over production reveal greed in your life?
- 4. What are some things the Bible teaches to help you overcome greed in your life?
