- 1. How does what we learn about John the Baptist's parents in Luke 1:5-7 help us understand the godly upbringing John must have had?
- 2. What do you think Zachariah believed was the best part of this news found in Luke 1:11-17? Name as many parts of this news as you can.
- 3. Why would Zachariah doubt the angel of the Lord, as stated in Luke 1:18?
- 4. Explain why John's ministry is so important according to John 1:29 and John 3:30?
- 5. In what ways does Luke 4:18-19 help us appreciate both Jesus and the ministry of John?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Describe something you hoped for, given up hope on, then had it happen only to be greater than anything you had dreamed?
- 2. How is John's life and ministry the first necessary gift to be unboxed to receive the gift of Jesus?
- 3. Why is it so necessary to unbox the gift of Jesus this Christmas?
- 4. Who can you share your journey of unboxing the gift of Jesus with this Christmas season?
