OPENING QUESTIONS

- 1. Do you have any post-Christmas traditions?
- 2. Share a time when you felt that God was with you even in a difficult situation.

IN THE WORD

- 1. In Matthew 2:13, why do you think God sends an angel to warn Joseph rather than stopping Herod with illness or death from trying to kill Jesus?
- 2. Name some ways God prepared Mary and Joseph for a journey to Egypt (Luke 2:1-7; Matthew 2:11-12). How does that give us hope in the middle of struggles?
- 3. Joseph obeys the angel immediately in Matthew 2:14. What were some of the challenges he had in his obedience and how do you think he overcame them?
- 4. What is Matthew's point in emphasizing God's watchful care over Jesus as read in Matthew 2:17,18,23; Hosea 11:1; and Jeremiah 31:15?
- 5. How does Matthew 2:19-20 encourage us in times of distress?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Why is obedience to God, such as Joseph's fleeing to Egypt, so important to us?
- 2. How do you remain calm and effectively listen to God even in the middle of an unexpected situation?
- 3. How can you know God's plan when you're in a bad situation?
