- 4. How does Matthew 5:13-16 describe someone who is unreligious?
- 5. If Jesus was at a party like the one in Luke 5:27-29, how could that confuse people about what religion is?
- 6. How can we avoid thinking like the Pharisees at the party in Luke 5:29-32?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Name some ways you can have a heart of high potency.
- 2. Share about a time you tried to be salty with someone who really needed Jesus but it did not work out well.
- 3. How can you have maximum impact on people's lives in the coming months?
