5. What does [Romans 13:11](#) mean to us today?
6. [Luke 12:37](#) encourages us to be on watch. What are some ways we can do this?

2. How is your behaviour affected by knowing that the time is short for Jesus' return?
3. In what way(s) are you showing that you are dressed and ready for Jesus' return?

5. Who do you need to tell about Jesus? How can you reach out to them this month?
