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OPENING QUESTIONS

IN THE WORD

- 1. Name some factors that hinder people from shining their light as found in Luke 8:16-18 NLT.
- Explain why just reading your Bible and not sinning aren't the only things that make you a Christians, according to Matthew 5:14-16 NIV.
- 3. Why is illumination of everything, as found in Luke 8:17 NLT, scary for people?
- 4. What does Luke 8:18 NLT mean in context with verse 17 NLT?
- 5. How can John 8:12 NIV impact the way we live this week?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. What does it mean for you to "take the lid off the light" in your life?
- 2. Name a way people can see God in your life. How does that bring glory to Him?
- 3. How can light illuminating everything be scary but at the same time bring confidence?
- 4. What does it mean for you to pay attention to the "dimmer switch"?
- 5. Share a way you can "get lit" this week.

CONTINUED LEARNING

1 John 1:5 through 2:11 NIV tells us more about the implications of shining the light of Christ in our lives. Pray over these verses asking God to illuminate a way to shine that light this week.
