BIG IDEA:

SCRIPTURE: Luke 8:16-18



OPENING QUESTIONS

1. Share a time when you began to understand how light overcomes darkness.
2. What is something you did as a kid that surprised your parents in a good way?

IN THE WORD

1. Name some factors that hinder people from shining their light as found in [Luke 8:16-18 NLT](#).
2. Explain why just reading your Bible and not sinning aren't the only things that make you a Christians, according to [Matthew 5:14-16 NIV](#).
3. Why is illumination of everything, as found in [Luke 8:17 NLT](#), scary for people?
4. What does [Luke 8:18 NLT](#) mean in context with [verse 17 NLT](#)?
5. How can [John 8:12 NIV](#) impact the way we live this week?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

1. What does it mean for you to “take the lid off the light” in your life?
2. Name a way people can see God in your life. How does that bring glory to Him?
3. How can light illuminating everything be scary but at the same time bring confidence?
4. What does it mean for you to pay attention to the “dimmer switch”?
5. Share a way you can “get lit” this week.

1 [John 1:5](#) through [2:11 NIV](#) tells us more about the implications of shining the light of Christ in our lives. Pray over these verses asking God to illuminate a way to shine that light this week.
