OPENING QUESTIONS

- 1. When you hear *Top Gun* what comes to mind for you?
- 2. Who was your wingman growing up?

IN THE WORD

- Genesis 2:18 tells us that even in creation it was not good for a person to be alone. Why do you think loneliness and isolation can be so dangerous?
- 2. Since our enemy, the Devil, according to 1 Peter 5:8 is looking to devour us, how can close relationships with others help us with that challenge?
- 3. In what ways have you seen the value of partnership as reflected in Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 work in other's lives?
- 4. What are some scriptures that come to mind reflecting the value of Christian community?
- 5. What does John 1:12 have to do with the need to have a wingman in our life? In what way does it challenge us to be a wingman to others?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. How has flying alone hurt you in your life?
- 2. What have you learned about picking a good wingman in your life?
- 3. Why do you believe you need both God and others to serve as your wingman?
- 4. Who are some of the people that serve as wingmen/ wingwomen to you?
- 5. Share some ways you are serving as a wingman/wingwoman to someone? Who would you like to serve in that way during this coming year?
- 6. Pray with a partner about how God can lead you to serve in this partnership of life with God.

Acts 21 reflects some of the close relationships and the need for others we all have to live this Christian life. Count how many people helped Paul and how many different ways the believers cared for him as well as each other.
