# **BIG IDEA:**

The unfinished life is trusting God.

**SCRIPTURE:** I Samuel 17

#### **OPENING QUESTIONS**

- 1. Who do you trust the most outside your family and why?
- 2. Where is the best place to get Mexican food?

#### IN THE WORD

- 1. What stands out to you in 1 Samuel 17:1-7?
- 2. Why do you think we see David's brother is so opposed to him in 1 Samuel 17:28? In what way does that apply to us in family relationships?
- 3. David's king does not trust his decision to fight, but what in 1 Samuel 17:34-36 helps to give David confidence to fight this battle?
- 4. Do you think David's confidence comes more from his own past experience in verse 34 or in the Lord's deliverance as stated in 1 Samuel 17:37? On what do you base your answer?
- 5. Why do you believe David did what he did in 1 Samuel 17:54?

#### MAKING IT PERSONAL

- What are David's motives in his encounter with Goliath? Do his motives matter?
- 2. David had past experiences of overcoming enemies that helped him deal with Goliath. When have you depended on how the Lord delivered in the past to give confidence for a challenging situation?
- 3. How have you seen overcoming the day-to-day challenges of life help you overcome the giant challenges that happen?
- 4. Share a spiritual "trophy" from your past that helps you today.
