- 1. How does the negativity of Ephesians 2:1-3 help clarify our purpose today?
- 2. In Ephesians 2:4-7 we read about the amazing thing God did for us. Put the concepts of these verses in your own words.
- 3. Name some ways Ephesians 2:8-9 allows us to pursue our idea of purpose in life.
- 4. Why is Ephesians 2:10 essential to living purposely?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. What kind of "messiness" in life tends to distract you from God's purpose?
- 2. How would you explain to a non-believing friend that Jesus' sacrifice 2,000 years ago gives us freedom to find purpose today?
- 3. Name some ways you reflect the beauty of God in your life.
- 4. What are some "good works" you believe God has prepared for you to do?
