- 1. Name some specific ways 2 Peter 1:3 gives you hope and direction as parents.
- 2. What does it mean to have confidence in approaching God in 1 John 5:14-15?
- 3. How does this participation in the divine nature work as talked about in 2 Peter 1:4?
- 4. Explain the truth of Philippians 4:8 and the impact it can have on a person's life.
- 5. Paraphrase Psalm 101:3 and share another scripture that illustrates this as well.

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. How do you tap into God's divine power in parenting, grandparenting, or even friendships?
- 2. Give an example of how you have seen prayer impact parenting or helped you handle a challenging relational issue.
- 3. Share a way you have felt the power of prayer help you or your child escape the corruption in the world.
- 4. When have you observed the "law of exposure" work for good or bad in your life?
- 5. What is one step you can take to live out the truth from God's Word you have discovered this week?
