- 1. Name at least one way that Jesus exemplified each of the characteristics of love in 1 Corinthians 13:4-8.
- 2. What does 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 teach us about love with feelings and actions working together? Can you have one without the other?
- 3. Which of the "love is..." statements in 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 is most important to you?
- 4. Which of the "It does not..." love characteristics in verses 4-8 is most important to remember in your relationships right now?
- 5. How can an accountability partner help with regard to 1 Corinthians 13:4-8?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. How does loving Jesus help you deal with others?
- 2. Share a recent time when you felt Jesus' love for you.
- 3. What characteristic of love do you need to work on the most to love others, especially your spouse, in a way they can receive it?
