- 2. Give an example of living by faith over fear.

IN THE WORD

- 1. Describe what it means to have the Lord as your shepherd in Psalm 23:1.
- 2. What in Psalm 23:2-3 can help us get through the challenging days in which we are currently living?
- 3. During these times, why is it so important to absorb the words of Psalm 23:4?
- 4. How would you explain Romans 8:31-32 to someone who is struggling with fear right now?
- 5. In what way does Psalm 23:5-6 help us starve our fears and feed out faith?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. How does God show He will provide for you?
- 2. What evidence of God's faithfulness in the past can bring you encouragement today?
- 3. Who can you share the light of Jesus with to help them deal with the darkness of fear, insecurity, and an the unknown near future we are all facing?

CONTINUED LEARNING

Psalm 30 continues to remind us to reach out to God for His help and healing. God will bring mercy and joy to those who seek Him.
