BIG IDEA:

SCRIPTURE: Luke 8:1-15

2. Explain what path, trampled on, and birds represent in [Luke 8:5](#).
3. Name some ways [James 1:21](#) can help us.
4. What does it mean to have no root, as talked about in [Luke 8:13](#)?
5. Looking at [Luke 8:7](#) and [Luke 8:14](#). Why is it so critical to deal with the thorns and weeds in our lives?
6. How can we step into all God has for us according to [Luke 8:15](#)?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

1. What does it mean to have an open mind to God? How do we deal with others that have a narrow mind or hardened heart toward God?
2. Share some ways you keep rooted in your life.
3. What are some distractions you deal with in your faith walk?
4. How do you keep distractions from getting your life off track?
5. Think of a time you have seen God produce fruit in your life and why you believe that happened.
