BIG IDEA:

The unfinished life live perseveres and does not quit.

SCRIPTURE: Hebrews 12:1-3

OPENING QUESTIONS

1. What was a discipline that you disliked as a child but now appreciate?
2. Share the best job you ever had and why you liked it.

IN THE WORD

1. Read [Hebrews 12:1](#). Name some hindrances that keep people from running the race that God intends for us.
2. [Hebrews 12:1](#) also tells us to “run with perseverance”. What does that mean?
3. [James 1:12](#) is a powerful verse. How does this verse encourage you?
4. Why is it so important to keep the end in mind when trying to live like Jesus as found in [Hebrews 12:2](#)?
5. How does [Hebrews 12:3](#) tell us to respond when faced with adversity or challenges even from those we love?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

1. What is one thing you need to put aside that may be hindering you from giving your best to God?
2. Fixing our eyes on Jesus is not always easy. Can you think of a time when you took your eyes off of Jesus? What was the outcome?
3. In 2019, how will you continue to keep your eyes focused on Jesus?
4. How have you seen hardship actually help you develop perseverance?
5. Name at least one way you can commit to persevere in your *Unfinished* journey.
